PEZ COSTUMES

So much of what we know about this PEZ collecting hobby is garnered from shared information from our "PEZ Pals."

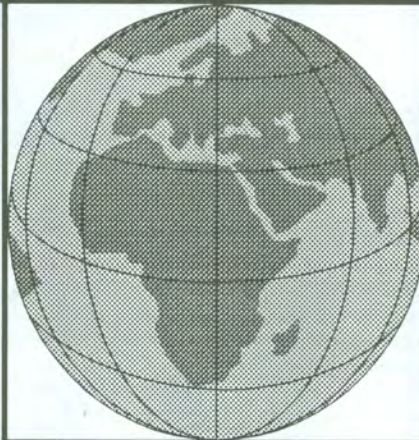
Right up front, I would like to say a word of sincere appreciation to the three people who shared info for this article. They are John "The Cool PEZ Man" Devlin, Charlene "The PEZ Snowbird" Henig and Maryann "Our PEZ Mentor" Kennedy.

Sometime in the early 1970s, colorful, fanciful and humorous looking costumes were created to dress up the plastic PEZ dispensers. These were printed on a heavy weight paper. And one costume was included in each dispenser package.

In the U.S., there were twenty-four different costumes issued. What fun!

Note the twelve "B" series costumes shown on page . Some of the other colorful costumes include and Astronaut suit, Roman toga, Pilgrim outfit and suit of armor.

Children could dress their PEZ

dispensers for hours of play-time fun. This 1970s series of costumes were pre-cut and glued. The children only needed to press the rectangular outfit into shape and insert their favorite footless PEZ in through the neck opening.

The costume was stiff enough to hold the footless PEZ upright.

One PEZ collector reports that she and her friends really did play with their "dressed up" PEZ. They made a little stage and held PEZ fashion shows. It was a fun rainy day activity.

Very few PEZ collectors have a complete "A" and "B" set of costumes today. A complete set of mint costumes could be valued as high as six hundred dollars.

At about the same time in the 1970s, a different type of PEZ cos-

tume was issued in Europe. These seem to be ultra rare today. As near as we can figure out, there were also about twenty-four designs in this series.

The theme throughout the European series seem to be Cowboys and Indians for the one set of twelve. And the other set shows various humorous outfits such as an Irmin robe, Pirate outfit, military suit and several lady's dresses.

These European costumes were shaped differently than the U.S. sets. They resemble paper doll costumes because they are more formed instead of being rectangular.

The series of 1990s costumes found in Spain somewhat resemble the 1970s series. However, there are some new designs. And these costumes are constructed a little differently. They have tabs that fold over the "shoulder" of the PEZ and they can be glued or taped onto the back piece which is folded up from the bottom.

These are, of course, for the new footed dispensers. That is why they need to have a different construction. You wouldn't be able to slide the feet through the neck hole as before.

Sometime, at a collectible show, you may be lucky enough to run across a 1970s Costume Cut-Out Book. These were issued as "send in for" premiums. Note the descriptions of these books by the illustrations on page 12.

All Frankenstein's have scars. Some have the scar painted red while others are the same color as the head.

The easiest way to differentiate between the Monkey Sailor and Donkey Kong Jr. is the "J" on the Dixie Cup (Navy term for the white hat the dispensers sport). If it has a yellow "J" then it's Donkey Kong Jr. If it doesn't have a "J" then it's Monkey Sailor.

What do MIP and MOC mean?

Some dispensers were molded with U.S. patent numbers, some with D.B.P. (German) patent numbers, and others with a Mexican patent number. And No, all dispensers didn't have patent numbers molded on them.

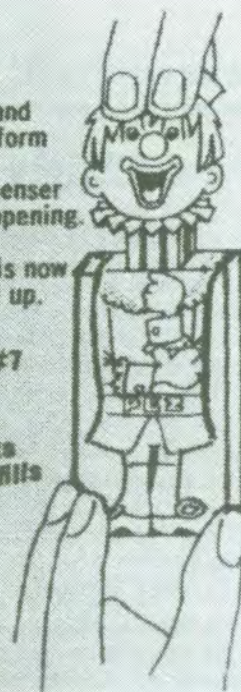
Please notify your readers to please, please beware of buying PEZ from toy shows and even, believe it or not, PEZ conventions. No they shouldn't stop because they are great places to buy PEZ, especially conventions. But tell them to beware. I have seen several dealers (some are your subscribers) sell "doctored" PEZ.

I saw one collector buy a red face Monkey with black baseball cap for over \$200. It's a simple trick: buy an orange face Monkey with black cap for \$20 and a red face Monkey with yellow cap for \$25. Exchange hats and sell both for a huge profit. I could go on and on about what I have seen, especially PEZ with switched stems. This is really a problem so please all you collectors beware. Please contact someone in the hobby you can trust 100% for assistance, and remember, when in doubt, don't buy it!

To Insert Dispenser:

PEZ-itive Returns

David Welch has never considered himself a "PEZhead." However, if the \$125,000 he has spent on PEZ memorabilia in the past four years is any indication, he's an addict. Welch, owner of Childhood Memorabilia of Murphysboro, Ill., says "some people think I'm crazy about PEZ, but I've never called myself a 'PEZhead'."

According to Welch, he owns several thousand dispensers, including his favorite, a late 1960s dispenser called the Psychedelic Eye, which he purchased for \$200. Welch, author of *A Pictorial Guide to Plastic Candy Dispensers Featuring PEZ*, says he is just one of hundreds of PEZ collectors willing to pay "big money" for the childhood toys, which sell for \$1.29 each. However, he believes the number of collectors is in the thousands, including those who buy the dispensers for a couple of dollars here and there.

Occasionally, rare dispensers and other PEZ related items will turn up at garage sales, antique stores, toy shows, and auction houses, says Welch.

Christie's East New York Entertainment Memorabilia and Collectibles auctioned 20 groups of over 100 dispensers late last spring. According to Timothy Luke, collectible's specialist, Christie's was the first major auction house to hold PEZ. Between 75 to 100 people bid on the assortment of dispensers, he added, pleasantly surprised at the collector's response.

As a result of the first auction's

success, Christie's, which collected \$8,000 in bids, has planned another PEZ auction for December 18. Among the 25 groups to be auctioned is a bride and groom dispenser set, priced about \$850.

What would inspire someone to spend hundreds of dollars on PEZ? According to Welch, nostalgia is usually the initial motive. "It's the love of your own childhood," he adds.

Scott McWhinnie, president of PEZ Candy, Orange, Conn., says "it's [PEZ] been collected by everybody." Although he doesn't collect them personally, he admits he has an "office-full" displayed at work.

Children collect it as a hobby also, but not necessarily as an investment, McWhinnie says. Teenagers buy it as a camp nostalgic product," he says; they buy them because it's "cool" to show their PEZ to their friends.

PEZ's popularity has inspired the development of several newsletters, including *Positively PEZ*, of Indianapolis, Ind., a bimonthly publication available since November 1992 that has about 500 subscribers worldwide. The newsletter, says publisher Larry LaFoe, addresses PEZ history, auction schedules, and prominent PEZ purchases.

According to Larry LaFoe, Welch, the self-proclaimed "non-PEZhead," paid the highest price for PEZ memorabilia when he purchased one of six European Make-A-Face dispensers for \$3,000 in August 1993.

[Larry's Note: Actually, according to Larry LaFoe, Welch sold the European Make-A-Face. Remember the old saying: Believe half of what you see and nothing of what you [read] hear.]

Characters, such as Mickey Mouse, who emerged on the market in 1961, have the potential to be bought and sold for up to \$100 depending on the version, says Welch.

It's doubtful that Eduard Haas III, the inventor of PEZ, could have imagined the demand for PEZ nearly seven decades after he introduced it in Vienna, Austria, as a peppermint, or "PfefferminZ" breath mint.

In 1927, instead of popping out a fruity, sugar candy, the original PEZ was an "established high quality" breath mint, says McWhinnie. At one time, adds Welch, PEZ Candy produced menthol, eucalyptus, and coffee flavored candy.

In the early 1950s, PEZ journeyed across the ocean to the United States. Following a 1952 market research investigation, says McWhinnie, fruity-flavored candy pellets in cartoon character dispensers replaced the peppermint breath mints in rectangular dispensers. The candy and toy combination was found to be more popular among children, its major consumer.

Today, PEZ's popularity persists; though, to the best of McWhinnie's knowledge, the candy company has never advertised the product. Each month, McWhinnie says, PEZ enthusiasts bombard the candy company with thousands of new character ideas. "You name it" it's been suggested," he says. However, all new PEZ creations are inspired from within the company.

Ed Dashiell, Giant Foods manager in Bloomsburg, says PEZ sells "particularly well during the holidays." He says it's "an impulse sale" and a "good stocking stuffer."

As a hobby, PEZ collecting has gotten much media attention. Welch says everyone wonders why some people would pay so much for a children's toy during these economic times.

Welch believes "there's a collector for virtually everything," but PEZ is popular because "they're kind of a unique item—there's nothing like them."

PEZ popularity shows no sign of Decline

Collector pockets \$2,000 for one dispenser

ORANGE, Conn. — What do Mickey Mouse, Kermit the Frog and a rose with an eyeball have in common?

Hint: It begins with the letter P, is derived from the German word for peppermint and comes in strawberry, orange, grape and lemon.

It smells like Jell-O when it's being made, lives fondly in the memories of countless baby

boomers and has been featured in movies, television shows and stand-up comedy routines.

The correct answer is, of course, PEZ.

Mickey, Kermit and the eyeball are three of the more than 200 heads that at one time or another have sat atop PEZ dispensers.

Scott McWhinnie also is on top of PEZ. He's chief executive officer of PEZ Candy Inc., a company that is just as hot in the age of Jurassic Park, Nintendo and Barney as it was during the era of Hula Hoops, Howdy Doody and Bobby socks.

To McWhinnie, 54, PEZ is something that needs no explanation — or advertising, for that matter. PEZ's cult-like popularity is echoed in every corner of his office.

"If I could have only one food for the rest of my life? That's easy. PEZ. Cherry flavor PEZ," reads copy from a poster for the movie "Stand By Me," tacked onto a wall facing McWhinnie.

Next to that is a Time magazine cover featuring the nostalgic toys and trinkets of the baby-boom years. There it is, in the lower left-hand corner: a PEZ dispenser with a Pluto head.

"Thanks for inventing PEZ!" reads an autograph from actor Charlie Sheen, who was supposed to pull PEZ out of a flight bag in a scene from the movie "Hot Shots," but the bit ended up on the cutting room floor.

No matter. PEZ keeps showing up everywhere else: on MTV, Seinfeld, "CBS This Morning," "Murphy Brown" and the David Letterman show, among others.

So why is PEZ so popular?

"I can't really explain that," said McWhinnie. "It's more than a candy. It's more than a plastic toy. I hate to use the word synergy, but it's beyond that."

For PEZophiles like 36-year-old Richard Geary of Madison, Ohio, it's way beyond that.

Geary routinely makes three-hour trips to the Canadian border just so he can get his hands on cherry PEZ, which is no longer made in the United States.

Geary has organized national PEZ conventions in Willoughby, Ohio, near Cleveland for the last three years. He started with about 75 collectors; this year, nearly 250 showed up to buy, sell and just look at rare PEZ dispensers.

Most go for between \$1 and \$25. But a headless dispenser with a witch stenciled on the side and a "Make A Face" dispenser resembling Mr. Potato Head recently sold for \$1,800 and \$2,000, respectively, Geary said.

Information Resources, Inc., a Chicago-based market research firm, estimates that PEZ sales in food stores, drugstores and mass merchandisers like Kmart reached \$18 million in 1992, up 25.6 percent from 1991.

say, "Aren't they beautiful?" and it's so much fun when you "do it yourself." Then it tells three easy steps to the construction of the outfit.

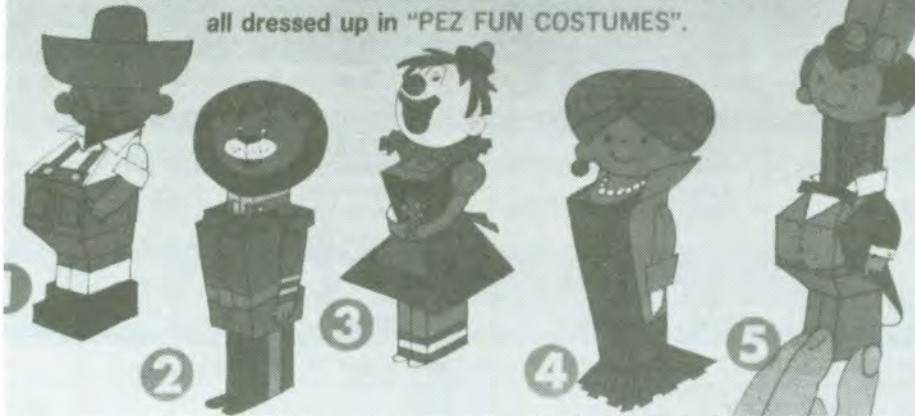
