Sue Sternfeld

PEZ: It's not just a candy, it's a way of life

Sue Sternfeld owns a living room full of PEZ dispensers, and she doesn't even like to eat the candy.

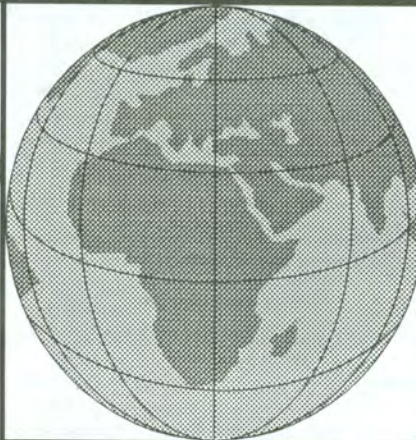
Sternfeld can properly claim to be the world's foremost celebrant of PEZ, the colorful plastic dispensers with heads on top that spit out tiny candies. She is, for example, the exclusive supplier of objet d'PEZ to Christie's auction house in New York City.

She even gets phone calls late at night from people asking goofy questions about PEZ. (More about that later.)

But on this day she is appearing at a toy expo in Orlando. As I approach, Sternfeld is telling several PEZ converts who have eagerly gathered at her tiny booth all about the history and timelessness of PEZ.

Created in 1927 as a peppermint candy by an Austrian nonsmoker, PEZ (a shortened version of the German word for peppermint) didn't make its way to the U.S. until after World War II.

At that point, proponents of the candy had to find a way to make it appealing and understandable to Americans, so they created the plastic dispenser with a character head (Mickey Mouse was said to

be the first PEZ icon) and changed the flavor of the candy from peppermint to mixed fruit.

Today there are more than 300 different types of PEZ all over the world. A rare PEZ could cost upwards of \$3,000, but one need not spend even a dime. Many in the benevolent worldwide PEZ community so love their PEZ that they are willing to trade or give away their spares for free.

Which is how Sternfeld got started just a few years ago. In Los Angeles on vacation, this former devotee of Disneyana noticed a man in the newspaper classified ads crying out for PEZ.

Her heart went out to him.

"The guy says PEZ! PEZ! I need PEZ! If you have PEZ, call me! I'm desperate for PEZ!" Sternfeld says.

So she packed up a Casper the Friendly Ghost (her only PEZ at the time) and paid this man a visit.

"He invited me to come to his house, which is a lot like PEZ collectors — they're very open and welcoming.... He said, 'Here's

my PEZ collection.' He pushes open the door to this room, and it knocked me out. It was *great!*" she says, broadly grinning and bending her knees as if she's going to jump up and cheer.

"It was plastic, it was nostalgic, it was character faces!" In exchange for her Casper, "he offered me his duplicates. I was taking so many I felt guilty."

As the cosmos would have it, Sternfeld also took home a newsletter that featured an ad by New York collectibles dealer Richie Sternfeld, who had lots of PEZ for sale.

"I was living in Missouri. ... I was calling all over the country. I was a possessed collector," she says. "So I kept calling Richie on a regular basis to see if he had any PEZ for sale. ... And after several months of \$1,000 phone bills, for each of us, he came out by train to St. Louis and asked me to marry him.

"Never saw him before. It was crazy."

They were married on a Tuesday in Massachusetts and drove the next day to the first annual PEZ-A-MANIA convention in Ohio.

Sternfeld, who has been married before, says marrying a PEZ man makes all the difference in the world. "He knew PEZ was going to get hot before PEZ knew PEZ was going to get hot," she says, casting her dark eyes toward her 50-year-old husband.

Richie looks back at his 37-year-old wife with an aw-schucks expression.

For 45 weekends each year, they leave their kids with babysitters at their co-op in Queens and head by station wagon to a show, where they can earn anywhere from

\$800 to \$24,000 selling and trading PEZ and a few other collectible toys. On the positive side, they have their weekdays free.

The better to spend time with the kids at home, a virtual plastic PEZ shrine. Sue has removed all furniture from the living room to make way for floor-to-ceiling PEZ cases. A loveseat remains, but soon, that too will be removed.

"People either sit on the floor or they cram into the loveseat," she says cheerily. "Most of our friends don't mind. They are collectors too. I really like sharing my information with them, showing them this Tom and Jerry or that Tom and Jerry. They really like the idea of having access to every known PEZ dispenser all at once. It's kind of overwhelming."

Hobbies: "Collecting absorbs a lot of my time."
Goals: My number one goal is to be on the Jay Leno Show, after that, I don't know... Bowl a 200 game.

The power of PEZ has propelled the Sternfelds to national prominence. They have been featured in *People* and *The Wall Street Journal* and on *Good Morning America*.

"Never would I have thought I'd say to some guy, 'I like your PEZ,' and end up like this," she says.

"I don't ever get bored with PEZ, I just sometimes get bored with answering the phone. People call me as late as 1 a.m., and they apologize and say, 'I hope you don't mind, I had this question about PEZ: What's the difference between Goofy A, Goofy B, Goofy C and Goofy D?'"

And, what is the difference? "Goofy A has removable teeth. Goofy B has a removable nose. Goofy C's teeth are one big bar. And Goofy D is what is in the store now; he has a green hat."

Sternfeld has some advice for anyone considering picking up the PEZ habit.

"If you're buying PEZ as an investment, and you're not buying them because you love them, keep them in the package, throw them in a box, put them under your bed, and go get therapy."

Pass a PEZ, please

Do you have any PEZ candy dispensers left in your knickknack drawer? They could be worth big bucks now. A rare PEZ "Make-A-Face" can sell for \$2,000, and many others are worth hundreds each, says Sue Sternfeld, owner of one of the world's largest PEZ dispenser collections.

"Collecting PEZ dispensers is like an addiction," warns Sternfeld. "There are at least 5,000 people in the U.S. who collect with some degree of seriousness, and about a dozen who wouldn't blink at paying \$1,000 for a particular dispenser." The item's so hot there's even an annual PEZ convention in Cleveland, Ohio.

PEZ, from the German word for peppermint, was developed in Austria in 1927, says Scott McWhinnie, president of PEZ Candy, Inc., in Orange, Connecticut. The candy got off to a slow start when brought to the U.S. in 1952 --- until the company added a toy head to the dispenser and targeted the children's market.

I also saw the PEZ gift boxes that Erin Duncan mentioned last issue. ABC stores (Hawaiian convenience stores on every corner) carry tow different PEZ gift packs. Both types are clear plastic boxes measuring roughly 6x8x1.5 inches, each containing a blue cardboard labeled "PEZ." The \$6.99 gift box contains five standard issue MIP dispensers each with two packages of candy. The \$9.99 gift box contains the five dispensers plus additional candy refills. Few boxes I saw contained four of one kind. ABC staff told me the gift

boxes were unique to ABC stores, assembled at the nearest ABC warehouse, including dispensers at random. I was able to persuade store clerks to break sets for the ones I wanted. They simply inserted single MIP dispensers (also sold at ABC) in their place, retaping the box. Happy PEZing!

The checklist denotes when the current dispensers were issued. (If you have an accurate date of production for one not listed, please let me know so I may update the list.)

PEZ is distributed like any other product; from manufacturer to distributor/wholesaler to retail outlet to consumer.

If you send a letter to PEZ they will route it to Richard Geary and then Richard will answer your question. Please allow him some leeway since he receives about 100 letters a month. But

to answer your question, if every one of the estimated 2500 PEZ collectors bought 100 PEZ each from retail outlets a year, then we collectors would consume less than 2 percent of the PEZ dispensers sold annually.

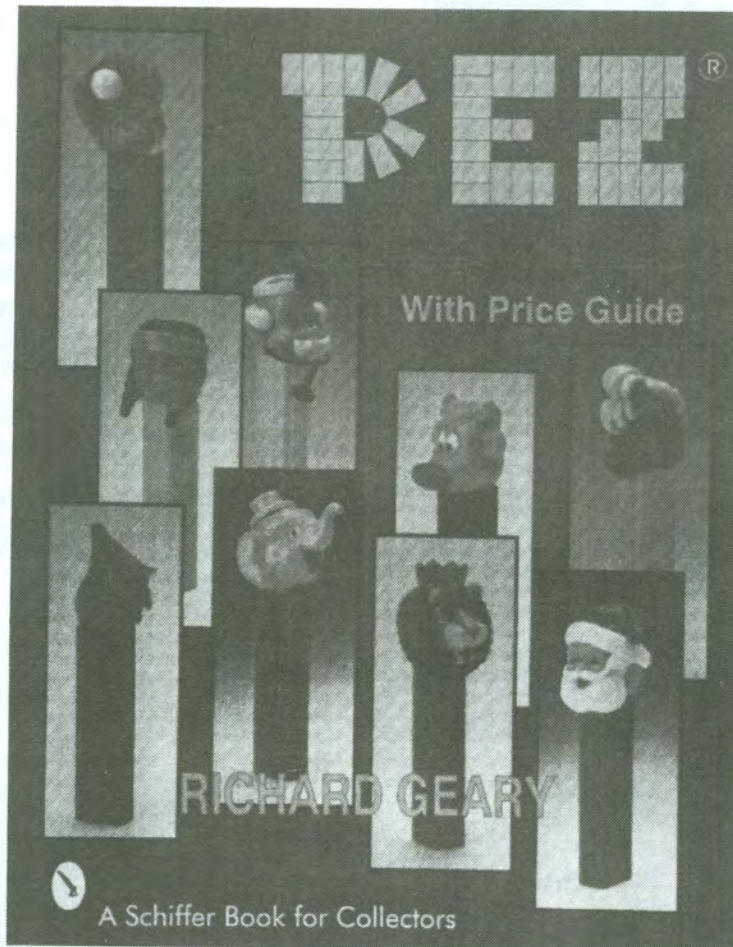

PEZ DISPENSER IS NOW AN ARTIFACT!

W eird science? Evidently on PEZ "Regular" became unearthed during an archeological excavation in southwest Oregon. Professor David Brauner (OSU - Anthropology Dept.) found the red translucent Regular under a dump site near a historic 1890s farm. The site is located on the upper Applegate River so named because the Applegate clan pioneered the old Oregon Trail along with the Clayton-Powell clan.

Finding PEZ in quick throw away nooks might seem odd but to collectors. I have even found a few PEZ on the original Clayton homestead owned by my mother-in-law June Clayton (Powell) Bean.

The 1992 dig at the Applegate location was not motivated by collectors, however, but simply a research effort. According to Brauner PEZ located at historic sites are increasingly profound for determining when the antique houses were occupied during the 20th century. Where this mysterious labor of dating dispensers will lead is unknown. Now that PEZ have inadvertently entered the field of archaeology Brauner likes them and is excited about challenging discoveries in the future. Other PEZ Regulars have been found beneath the rotting floors of an old house (1859) in Dayton, Oregon.

Once identified the dispensers are meticulously cleaned then dated using patent numbers and/or head characters as a reference. The PEZ are also cataloged and analyzed. Dispensers are delegated to boxes within campus archives after the research has been done.

Usually a student is assigned to researching one particular item. Then a paper denoting descriptive facts is required from the student.

During the winter of 1992 Mike and I received a plaintive call from Toby Martin. Professor Brauner assigned the task of

analyzing the "Applegate PEZ" to Toby. A student in Anthropology 430 at Oregon State University, Toby needs to write a paper about the Regular for credit.

Mary Martin (Toby's wife) has worked with Mike for years in the area of alcohol/drug rehabilitation. Mary is well aware that collecting PEZ is a favorite hobby in our home and obviously relayed this information to Toby. Back in '92 we only had a small collection and didn't know nearly as much as we do now.

Toby knew nothing about PEZ and wanted to interview Mike. We recommended David Welch's "Pictorial Guide to Plastic Candy Dispensers" as the only source for identifying PEZ using color photos that we were aware of. Although Toby had a deadline to meet and didn't get Welch's guide, Brauner now owns a copy for research purposes and I quite pleased with it. Toby Martin's brief but concise artifact description was informative enough for the Anthropology Dept. at OSU in 1992. Now a new research paper is in the works by yet another student as the hunt for PEZ goes on.

Description:

The artifact is two molded plastic rectangular tubes, one fitting inside the other.

The outer shell is a simple tube measuring 2.8 inches tall, 0.75 inches wide, and 0.5 inches deep. This tube is colored a pinkish red with an occasional lightening in shade or loss of color (transparent). Centered along one side is a 0.15 inch wide clear strip running parallel to the axis of the tube through which a spring can be seen. The opposite side is entirely devoid of coloration and the spring is easily visible.

On the front and back there are textured regions 2.25 inches tall by 0.6 inches wide. In this region, on one side, is the word "PEZ." The letters are large, 0.5 inches high, run parallel to the axis of the tube, and are spaced to fill the entire textured region. The letters are written in a fanciful font, designed to look as if

each letter were constructed of blocks.

The same word, "PEZ," in the same font, appears in the textured region of the opposite side. This time the letters are 0.3 inches tall and run perpendicular to the axis of the tube. However, they are stacked on top of each other. The bottom 0.5 inch of the textured region contains the lines:

U.S. PATENT
2,620,061
MADE IN
GERMANY
U.S. ZONE

in a plain font with 0.1 inch high letters.

The white inner tube fits snugly into the outer, but is 0.5 inches taller (3.3 inches). The top is fitted with a white molded plastic endcap, attached by a pin running through both tube and cap, slightly offset from center. The cap pivots about the mounting pin, and has a central ridge with transverse ribs, providing a thumb grip for the opening of the tube by means of pivoting the cap. The bottom of the tube is molded shut. Riding inside the tube is a spring loaded platform.

Manufacture:

The artifact is made of multiple pieces of molded plastic, along with a metal spring and a metal pivot pin. Both the spring and the pivot pin look to be off the shelf items easily purchased by a plastics manufacturer. According to the inscription, the artifact was manufactured in Germany, U.S. Zone.

U.S. Patent 2,620,061 was applied for on 14 October 1949 (28 Oct. 1948 in Austria), but was not granted until 2 December 1952. That the first application was in Austria and that the U.S. application was by Oskar Uxa as an assignor to Eduard Haas, both of Austria, confirms Frankish origins. Since the patent number is molded into the device, it must have been manufactured after 2 December 1952. However, similar devices with different patent numbers are still made today. According to PEZ collector Michael Bean of Eugene, Oregon, there is only one reference for PEZ dispensers, "The Pictorial Guide to Plastic Candy

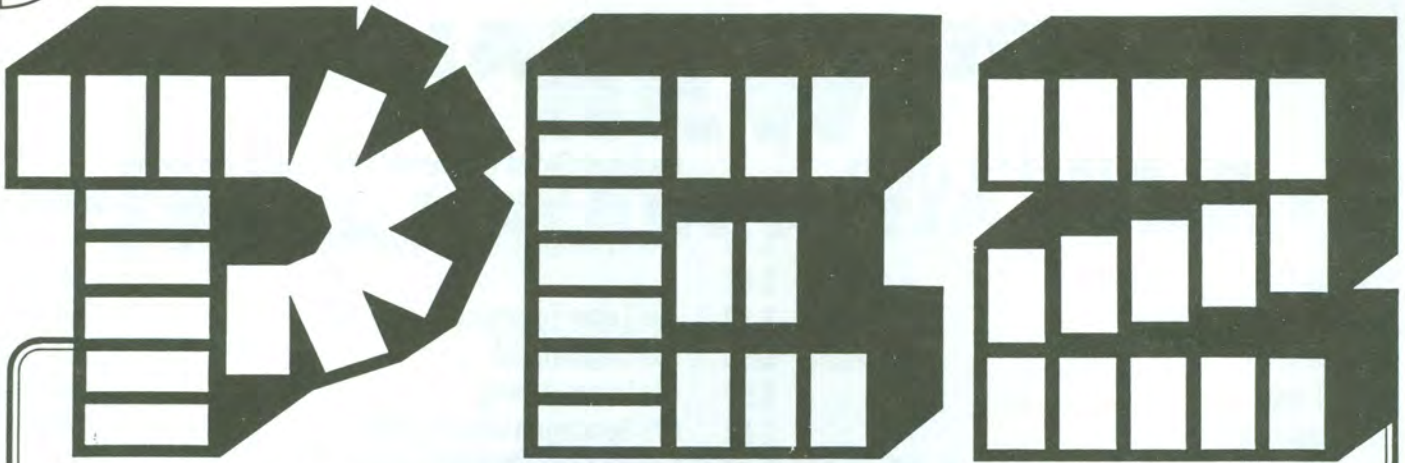

Function:

The description of U.S. Patent 2,620,061 in the Official Gazette is a "Pocket Article Dispensing Container." Its function being to individually

dispense tablets (or the like) from an internal stack. Current directions for the use of PEZ Dispensers indicate, "to fill your PEZ dispenser with PEZ candy... and have fun eating delicious PEZ candy."

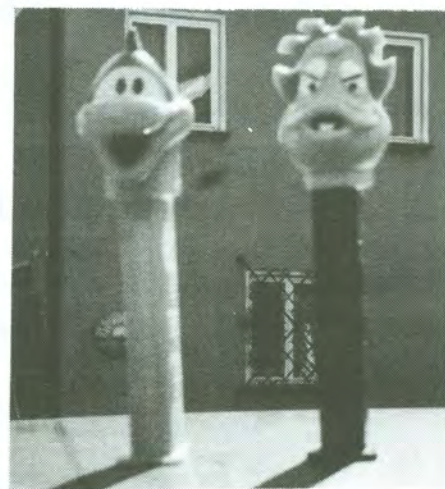
