PEZ-ZAZZ

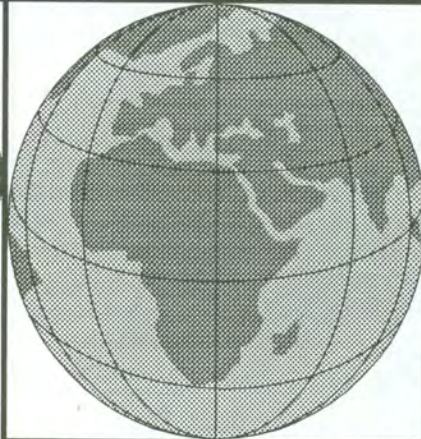
Find out why collectors are flipping their lids over these dandy candy dispensers.

It's a familiar mainstay of the checkout aisles of supermarkets across the nation, a prime impulse buy, tucked between the candy bars and key chain flashlights. You've seen them at yard sales, flea markets and antique shows. And whether you are six or sixty, at least once in your life you have owned one—a PEZ dispenser.

The recent rise in popularity of these colorful plastic gizmos comes across in shows like *Married With Children*, *Cheers*, *thirtysomething* and *Murphy Brown*. Indeed, *Seinfeld* revolved an entire episode around the Tweety dispenser.

But when the prestigious Christie's auction house in Manhattan included several lots of PEZ in a recent collectibles auction, it became clear that the candy container was a main contender in the market.

PEZ has been around a lot longer than most people realize. The candy was created in 1927 by Eudard Haas III, an Austrian food

merchant. Haas was a creative businessman with a detailed knowledge of the properties of peppermint oil. He created the small rectangular candy as a breath mint and, advertised as an alternative to smoking, it became extremely popular and quite fashionable. Haas named his brick-shaped candies "PEZ," pronounceable and easily understood the world over, by using the first, middle and last letters of the German word for peppermint, "P feff E rmin Z."

In 1939 PEZ fell victim to the rationing measures of wartime. Available supplies and manpower decreased as hostilities increased. PEZ ceased production until the late 1940s, at which time the familiar blue and gold packaging returned. Soon thereafter the invention of the brilliantly constructed "PEZ BOX" enabled consumers to conveniently take their sweets from the "easy, handy, hygienic pocket dispenser." These headless PEZ boxes sold in the millions across Europe. The American market had yet to be tapped.

As PEZ entered this country in 1952,

market research suggested adaptability "to suit the American mentality and their love of games." Further, it was agreed that they should introduce their product as a line geared toward children. This led to the inclusion of fruit flavors and the immediately popular and collectible character heads featuring holiday and popular licensed characters.

It is not known for certain which character head was first to appear. Opinions differ among collectors, and there are apparently no records. General opinion suggests that the first generation of characters were the original holiday dispensers (One-Piece Witch, Original Easter Bunnies A & B, and Santa A), Popeye, Mickey Mouse, Donald Duck, a Space Gun, the full-bodied Robot and the full-bodied Santa Claus.

Headless dispensers called "regular," resemble disposable lighters, and serious collectors acquire these, as well. They include the original PEZ BOX, the U.S. Zone Regular (marked Occupied Germany), advertising regulars, Witch Regular (the witch is painted on the side), Golden Glow (a premium offered for ten empty candy wrappers and 25 cents), and finally, Arithmetic (a dispenser that answers multiplication problems).

One of the reasons for the popularity of PEZ is that it is one of the few collections that lets you acquire entries in just about any grocery store, most selling from .99 cents to \$1.29. There have been approximately 300 different heads manufactured and available to the general public since 1949, with at least 75 different dispensers currently available in retail stores worldwide for \$2.50 or less. Approximately 150 more can be found for between \$5 and \$100.

The variety of heads may account for the mass appeal of PEZ, with almost fifty different Disney heads, fifteen Looney Tune characters, and numerous superheroes and villains. There are monsters, astronauts, historical figures, animal heads and a large variety of trucks. Holiday collectors will find four different Santas, nine Easter characters, and witches, pumpkins and ghouls in several colors.

An impressive number of licensed characters make it to the top of a PEZ dispenser. They are Garfield and his friends, the Muppets, Peanuts characters, Olive Oyl, Brutus and three different varieties of Popeye, Smurfs, Orphan Annie, Bullwinkle, Bozo, Casper, and the newest additions to the PEZ line, the Flintstones.

For those who want to start a PEZ collection, large chain stores or drug stores can be a good source for the current issues. Still, not all character heads can be found in the United States. If you have friends visiting or living in Canada or Europe, ask them to check their stores for a wider variety. For older dispensers, you can try flea markets, yard sales, toy and antique shows and shops. There are also a few mail order dealers who have a large selection of older, hard-to-find dispensers.

To help locate such dealers, and to gain knowledge concerning prices (there is currently no accurate or reliable price guide available to collectors), beginners might look into the PEZ newsletter, POSITIVELY PEZ. Published by Crystal and Larry LaFoe, subscriptions are \$18 a year for six issues. Bargains, trades, stories, photos, letters and classified ads can be found here, plus news about upcoming PEZ conventions. Another must for the PEZ collector is David Welch's book, *A Pictorial Guide to Plastic Candy Dispensers* [P.O. Box 714, Murphysboro, IL 62966 (618) 687-2282]. This glossy, full-color book features most PEZ dispensers and their descriptions.

There are many attractive things about this hobby. Great faces, popular characters, bright colors, nostalgic appeal—and they make you feel good.

The fact that owning and displaying ten common dispensers can turn you into an instantly popular person is only a bonus!

10 BUYING AND STORING TIPS

1. If you are collecting PEZ because you love them, take them out of the bags and enjoy them. The cellophane or poly bags have no value.
2. Some PEZ come on cards. Keep intact, these will increase in value, particularly if the card itself is an unusual shape, offers a contest or giveaway. Also, keep the dispenser mint in the package. The packaging could prove to be more valuable than the dispenser.
3. All pink, blue, and yellow striped packages are generic packaging and extremely common; open these and enjoy your new dispenser.
4. The Stand By Me dispenser is actually a packaged set, and should always be kept in the package. Authenticity is dependent on its remaining intact. Originally distributed by Columbia Pictures, the set consists of a PEZ Pal Boy, candy, and a miniaturized poster from the movie.
5. Original packaging should be retained with the 1970 Candy Shooter, the 1980 Space Gun and the Make-A-Face. These dispensers will lose value if removed from their cards.
6. If you are buying PEZ only as an investment, keep them all packaged. Sort them into cardboard boxes for dark storage, as light will affect the colors.
7. This plastic has a tendency to react with rubber and other plastics, so keep loose dispensers well protected from such materials.
8. Do not buy dispensers with missing pieces. It isn't likely that you will find the parts you need at a later date and there is no market for items with cracks, melt marks, non-functioning mechanisms or missing parts.
9. Focus your collecting attention on the heads of the dispensers. Whether the dispenser comes from Austria, Hong Kong, or Hungary really doesn't matter. If you try to find one from each country, you'll wind up with a garage full of duplicates.
10. To avoid misleading information, try to find out who the knowledgeable dealers are, and stick with them.

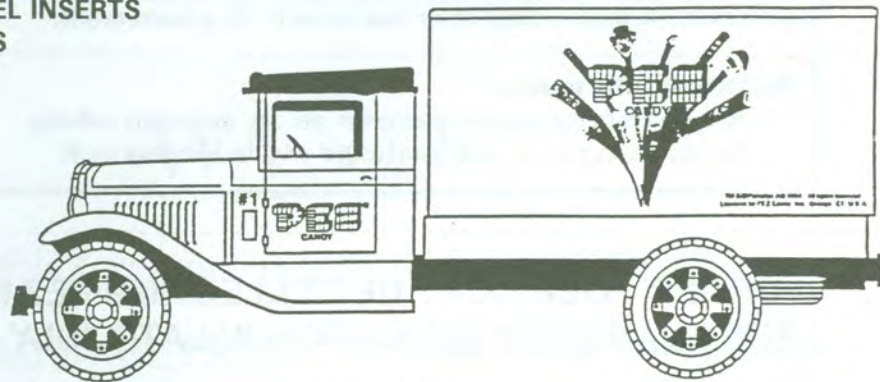
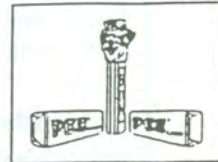

The 2nd Annual National PEZ Collectors Convention

Over 150 people attended this year's convention making it the best convention yet, held in St. Louis.

Welcome to what will be a regular segment in each issue of "Positively PEZ."

Now being the "PEZ Meister" does not mean I know everything, or that I have the final say, fact is there are more knowledgeable collectors than I, but they would rather keep the information to themselves instead of sharing it.

This first section is on vending machines. Now I have information from a company in Fairfield, NJ. They are still in business and they maintain equipment to fabricate, weld, point, silk screen and assemble a finished product to suit your needs, in this case, PEZ, Inc.'s needs.

In the late 1960s Bloomfield Manufacturing had assigned Angus Brown, an employee, to a project, he had to come up with a machine that could dispense merchandise through a chute in a machine.

In the spring of 1969 on March 11th a patent was granted to the company and Angus Brown for a machine (In fact I have the original patent papers for these machines, also original blueprints.) that would be installed in supermarkets, variety stores, theaters, lobbies and hotels. The four different machines that I am aware of are pictured. The list of PEZ dispensers available for these machines would make any PEZ Head do flips. I don't recall these machines personally, but I love to see them return. They are still being used in Germany. See picture in last issue.

Later years would bring vending boxes and displays, Hey! maybe that would be a great section to write about. Until next time, Yours in PEZ, The "PEZ Meister."

My PEZ Addiction

I have become aware that my PEZ collecting has crossed the line and entered into the world of addiction. Here's what happened to me. I'm sure most of you can relate to these symptoms.

It begins with a collection of a dozen or so PEZ dispensers. You continue buying the new ones that come out. As your interest in PEZ grows, like an interest in a new car, you begin to notice them everywhere. They are in antique malls, flea markets, drug stores, and sometimes at garage sales. You ask your close friends to keep an eye out for PEZ dispensers for you.

You now go beyond your safe circle of close friends and ask your family, co-workers, and neighbors if they have any laying around and ask if they too will keep an eye out for you. By now, you have more or less established yourself as a PEZ collector. Before you know it PEZ information floods in. You hear about a PEZ dispenser in a store 70 miles away from your home. You drive there. You spend your weekends traveling to other cities to search for them. You notice the advertisements in newspapers, collectors magazines, and publications. You begin to add PEZ resources to your personal phone book and business card holder. You may even set up a filing system of PEZ

retailers/dealers. Your phone bill begins to increase. Your collection begins to increase. Your excitement begins to increase. Your addiction has begun to set in.

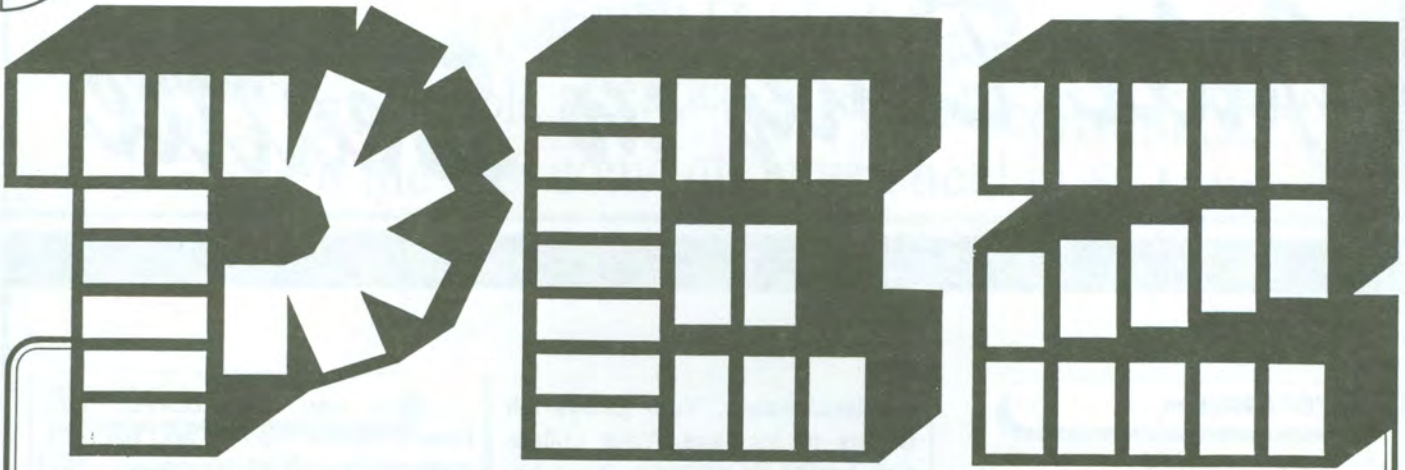
You start spending countless hours making lists of all the PEZ you have. You sort them, count them, separate them, play with them, and eat the candy. At some point you realize that PEZ is not limited only to dispensers, but there's advertising memorabilia. You want it all - every dispenser, every PEZ-related item! Then you are brought down to earth. You realize that you would have to be wealthy in order to have everything. You vacillate between I quit! Forget it! I'll never have them all! to I want them all. I'm willing to work overtime or save my monthly coffee money just to buy a Pooh PEZ!

You buy PEZ like an out-of-control maniac from people all over the world. When you return home from work you are elated when you have received a PEZ shipment. Sometimes you don't wait until you get home and you phone from work to see if anyone left anything for you. The flip side to this, is that you become depressed when you don't receive anything. To get a PEZ fix, you dip into your savings or you use the money you would have spent meeting your friend for dinner on Saturday night to order a PEZ. You contemplate disconnecting the TV cable channels so that you have an extra \$50 each month to spend.

Now you are hooked. You have crossed the line and become addicted to PEZ. You save PEZ price lists, subscribe to Positively PEZ newsletter, and purchase collectible toy books and books on candy dispensers collecting. You swear you will buy a computer to create a PEZ data base just to keep it all straight. Your buying frenzy continues. You rationalize to your spouse and family that you collect them because they are small and they hardly take up any space. When you run into someone who has never heard of collecting such a thing, you gladly share your knowledge and excitement about your collection with them. You proudly show them pictures of your PEZ, like a grandmother bragging about a grandchild. When everyone has heard about your PEZ and there is no one else to talk to, you open your little black book and pull out the telephone number of a co-PEZZER. By calling a co-PEZZER you hear about all the new exciting PEZ stuff coming out of Europe. You order more.

More advanced PEZ collectors attend PEZ conventions. They even get into the PEZ selling or trading business. Some create special names for themselves, such as John The Cool PEZ Man Devlin or Richard the PEZ Meister Geary. As a PEZ addict you don't particularly take offense to being called a PEZaholic or a PEZhead. You even begin to speak PEZ language (2.9s, 3.9s, stems, sticks,

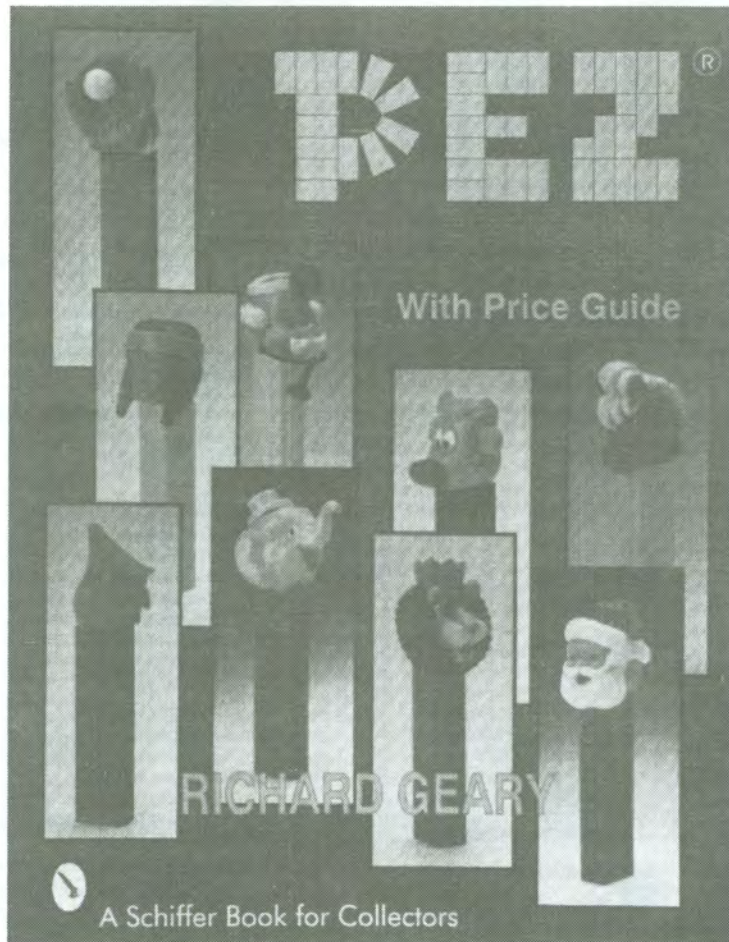

heads, cards, MIB, etc). My worst symptom of PEZ addiction? When I became more concerned about whether Nancy or Tonya would win a medal.

So why continue to buy PEZ and submit yourself to such torture? There are many reasons: you meet other collectors who are such nice people; everyone knows what a PEZ dispenser is, but only a small percentage of people ever think about collecting PEZ; each time you see one you re-live a little bit of your childhood; you can travel searching for them (which can include travel to Europe); and you always have a conversation about something tucked away on reserve for those awkward social situations. The question should not be why continue, but why not?

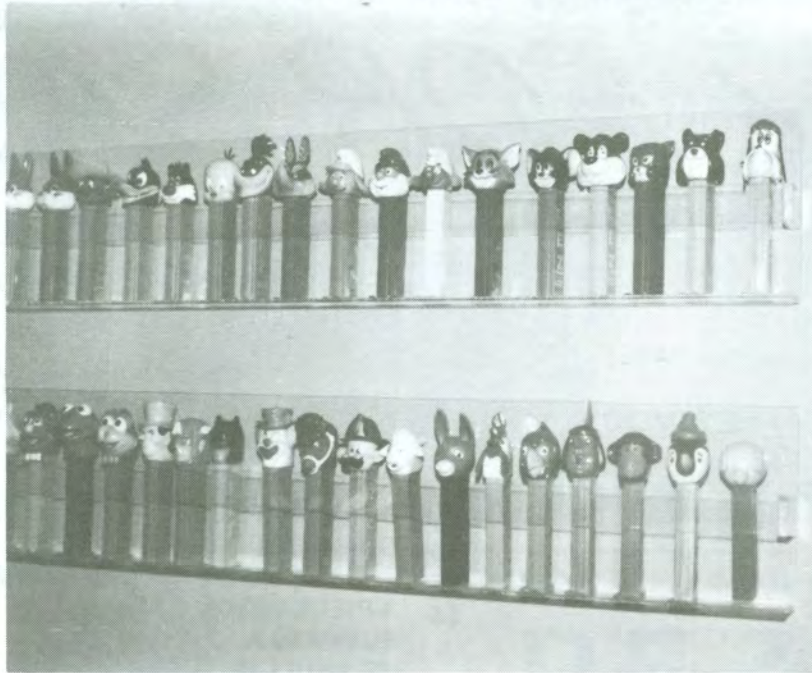
