Those little Clicking on
candy dispensers are a hot
collectible **PEZ**

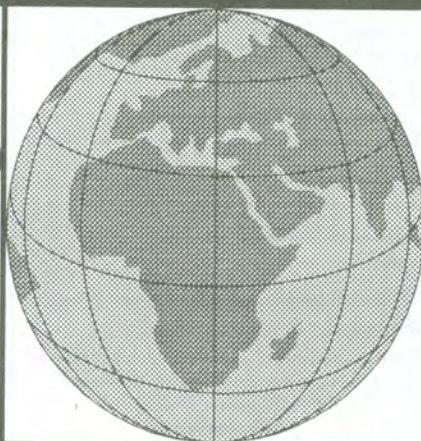
The Ph.D. after Adam Manasterski's name indicates his degree in biochemistry; it does not stand for doctor of PEZ-holders. The Troy clinical chemist does possess some 160 different kinds of PEZ dispensers, but that hardly makes him an advanced collector.

"I just started last year," he says.

Maria Straus of Swartz Creek, near Flint, has been collecting PEZ dispensers for four years and has more than 210, but she too, is a relative newcomer to the hobby.

"Advanced collectors are people who have been at it 10-to-25 years. There are a lot of novice collectors in Michigan," says Richard Geary, author of the book "PEZ Collectibles" and organizer of last month's PEZ-A-Mania convention in Madison, Ohio, northeast of Cleveland, which attracted 500 participants.

On their way to PEZ-A-Mania, Manasterski and his son and co-collector Michael, 14, stopped at an antique store where they stumbled

upon a PEZ dispenser from the 1950s, one of the plain ones, without an animal or cartoon character head. They paid \$5 for it — "very inexpen-

Where did the word "PEZ" come from, anyway?

It's the abbreviation of pfefferminz, the German word for peppermint. Austrian Eduard Haas invented PEZ in 1927 as an adult candy, marketed as an aid to quit smoking.

sive compared to the price a true collector could charge; \$100 or over," says Manasterski, 48. Not that he's willing to sell it. "We have none of the old ones for sale."

If Manasterski and Straus are typical, there is more to this hobby than

accumulating things in hope they'll increase in value. PEZ collectors seem to genuinely like the objects they collect.

"The characters' faces are very artistically done," Manasterski comments. "Aesthetically, they're very pleasing to me."

"They're colorful and they're little and they just make you feel happy," says Maria Straus.

"You can line them up and count them and look at them. And," she says, thanks to her hobby "I've met a whole lot of people."

She became a PEZ collector after reading an article about another collector, "First I went around to all the drug stores and Kmart and looked for the kind you can get for \$1. You can find about 50 different kinds that way. The first day, I spent \$17. I thought, 'Oh man, this is going to be an expensive hobby,'" she recalls.

It has become expensive, she adds, "but it's so much fun." Among her favorite — "not necessarily most valuable" — dispensers are the Disney characters Pinocchio and Jiminy Cricket; a brown-haired Nurse, an Angel and a Pony.

Her most valuable pieces are "probably Peter Pan and Tinkerbell," from the Disney cartoon. "They're worth about \$75 each."

Stuck on PEZ

Stickers (sometimes referred to as badges or patches) and tattoos are colorful, fun "go-withs" for your PEZ collection. There are several different styles. The round ones were originally found in a packaged PEZ dispenser and occasionally placed in a package of refills. Most of the tattoos seem to have been found in the refill packages.

Another type of sticker had a faceless character with separate eyes, ears and mouths which could be placed on the face to complete the character.

There were also stickers made to resemble stamps; these were placed in refill packages along with an advertisement for an album. The advertisement urged the customer to collect all 48, depicting space, UFO's and wild animals.

I've been inventorying my collection and have noticed I have some that are not on your checklist.

I have three Donald Ducks, two have feet yet are completely different. The hats are not the same, neither are the beaks or eyes. I can obviously tell which one is the newest. So there should be a A, B and C.

Also should there be a Chick in Egg w/Hat A and B, because one has feet and one doesn't? The same goes for Fat Ear Bunny.

When heads with color variations are discussed, are two different shades of a color included? I have Pumpkin B in a dark orange and in a pale orange. My Captain America has two shades of flesh tone on the faces.

Donald Duck A was issued with and without feet, so the two variations that you currently own are Donald Duck A and B.

Just because a dispenser was issued with and without feet doesn't merit two different designations. The separate designations are reserved for different mold variations.

Since dispensers were made at numerous manufacturing plants over the years, you have to expect different some color variation due to modifications of the basic color recipe. Some people collect color variations no matter how slight the difference in hue, while others may require a noticeable difference at x amount of feet.

As for me, I started collecting one of each dispenser until I reached a predetermined dollar amount for a single dispenser. Once I bought all available dispensers at my pre-established limit, I then started collecting color variations to satisfy my collecting needs.

1. Concerning your checklist, instead of using A, B, C, etc. to differentiate dispensers, can't you be specific? i.e., Droopy w/Moveable Ears, Droopy w/Painted Ears.

Alpha designators were used to condense the checklist so that it would fit onto one page. I did change some of the listings to reflect your request. However, I was limited by the space available. The end result was a very busy checklist. Let me know if you have any ideas of what abbreviations to use to make the checklist more useable for all collectors.

To further aid in your identification of PEZ dispensers, I would recommend that you buy one of the three PEZ Guides available today. Richard Geary has one that is available at national bookstores, i.e., Barnes & Noble, etc. and David Welch has two available at antique stores, toy shows and flea markets nationwide.

I currently have two back issues available, Nov/Dec 1993 and May/June 1994. You can also buy them through the classifieds from subscribers who

are reproducing them for other collectors.

The Elvis PEZ that you saw in "The Client" was not real! Someone placed a toy Elvis head on top of a PEZ stem to make it look like a PEZ.

PEZ is available to consumers the same way every other consumable is available to us. The retailer chooses what PEZ he wants to sell and then buys a minimum quantity from his distributor. If you would like to see different PEZ in your local PEZ retail store, ask the manager to order different PEZ the next time he orders from his distributor.

There are two different PEZ companies in this world of ours. One in Vienna, Austria, Ed. Haas, Gmbh and one in the United States, PEZ Candy, Inc. Since they are separate entities, there will be differences in the items that are offered by them. The Austrian factory supplies Europe, Canada and Australia, while the United States factory supplies only the United States. I'm sorry you don't think it's fair, but that's what puts some challenge into this hobby of ours.

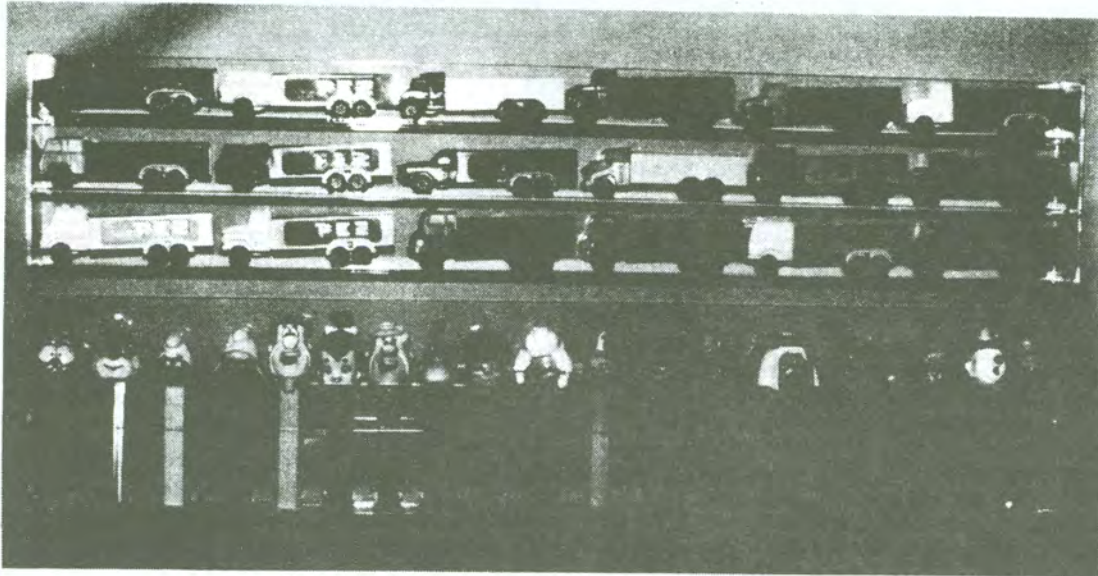
A recent article in a magazine showed a picture of a Pillsbury Doughboy PEZ. Do you know when it is due out?

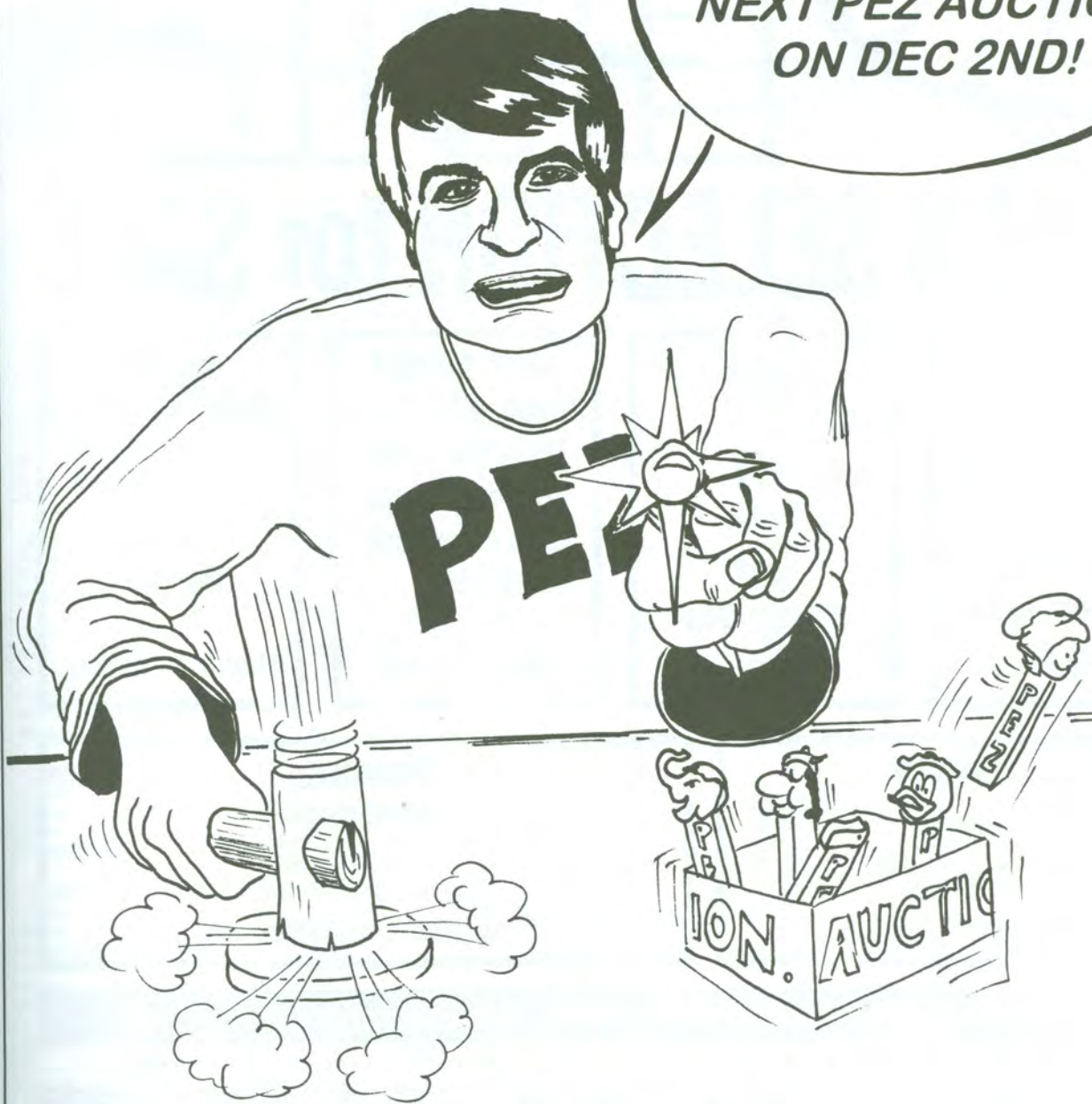

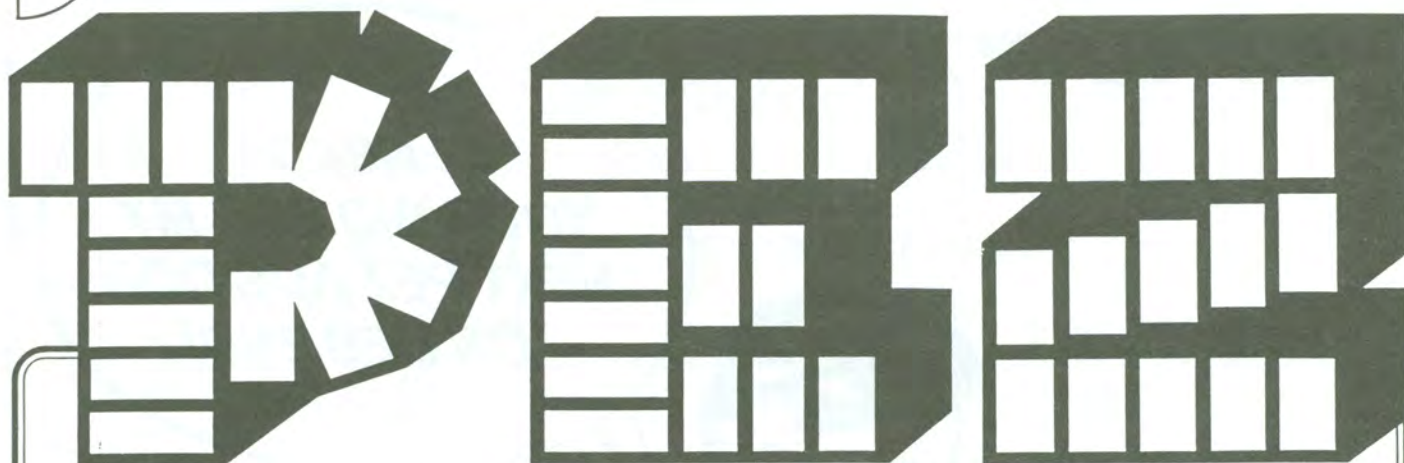

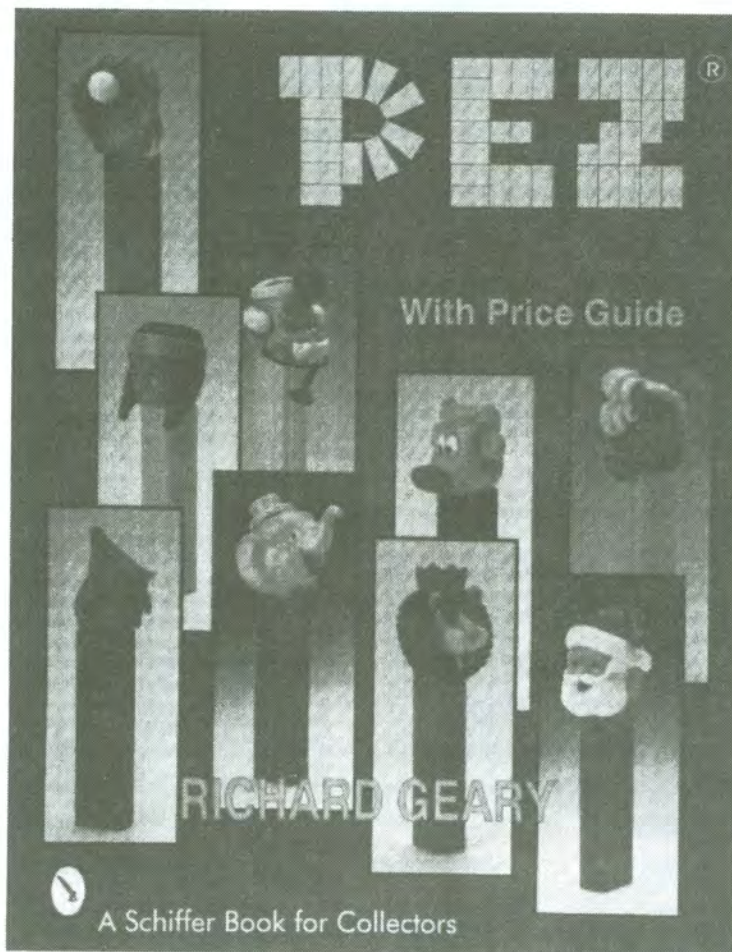

PIF, The World's Funniest Dog

Since 1984, German and Austrian kids have enjoyed a Comic magazine called YPS. It is issued weekly with one outstanding feature, each issue contains a free little gift, called a "Gimmick." These gimmicks are made especially for the young readers and concentrates mainly on leisure time activities like sports, hiking, cowboy and Indian adventures and sometimes, simple snap together toys are enclosed. These gimmicks are placed on top of the magazine and both are wrapped in transparent shrink wrap, so the toy does not come loose during transit. I guess the news stands hate the YPS magazines since they are so difficult to display with the enclosed gimmicks.

I believe it was around 1989 when one of those restless gimmick inventors approached Haas and asked for a specially designed dispenser suitable for their magazine. Who knows, maybe it was the other way around. Having a free commercial advertising feature to reach 70,000+ potential customers, Haas agreed and the chosen character was PIF, the world's funniest dog.

To keep costs down, a simple one-piece molding of PIFs head was made. Cast in a bright yellow, it featured no painted details. PIF is cast in capital letters on the left ear with the available stem colors in red, green or blue with the 3.9 patent number. Each dispenser came with one refill pack of tangerine drops.

The front page of the magazine shows a huge PIF dispenser with masked Indian comic characters

dancing around him. The back cover shows a boy and girl flipping PIFs head open to dispense a candy. On page 4 of the magazine, a special comic strip is devoted to the dispenser, which in this case is filled with especially hot pepper candies. Similar to the 1970s Super Mints! (I have a few if you would like to try one.) Page 5 shows how to fill the dispenser with the not so hot tangerine candies.

I found my first PIF at a flea market. To get some duplicates, I advertised forever to search for this special gimmick. Not a single offer. I even phoned the YPS editorial office and tried to find some there. It was much too late; they didn't even remember the gimmick. I then went dumpster diving, I came across some PIFs that were long forgotten. (I arrived two weeks late to retrieve a mint bag of Make-A-Faces that were pulverized to make new dispensers. This is why few older dispensers are available, they are recycled!)

The PIF dispenser was never available in candy stores. It was only sold with this issue of the YPS comic and that makes it comparatively rare. Since it features one of the leading characters of the YPS comic, the PIF dispenser can be regarded as a promotional issue and should therefore be in the same group of premiums as the Lion's Club, Hippo and Stand By Me.

The likelihood of finding one at a garage sale in the United States is nearly (if not exactly) zero. In Germany or Austria, you may have more luck. But you have to compete with the gimmick collectors too. I wish everyone good luck in their search for their own PIF dispenser.

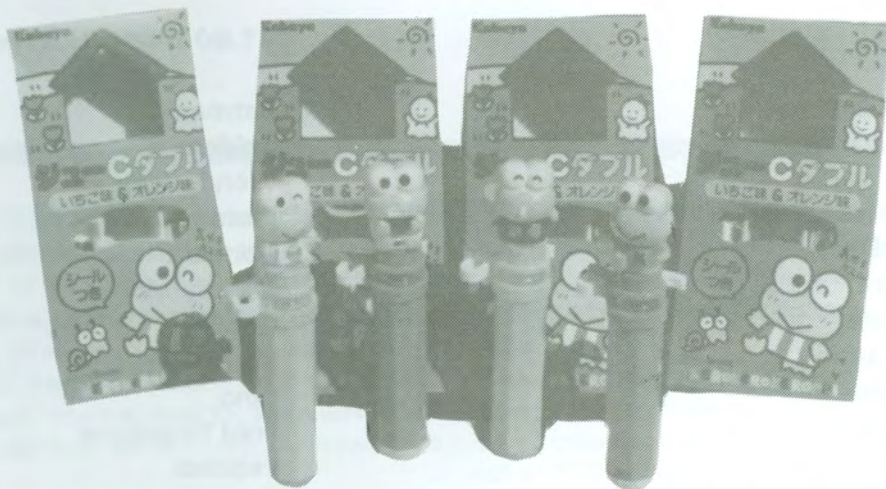

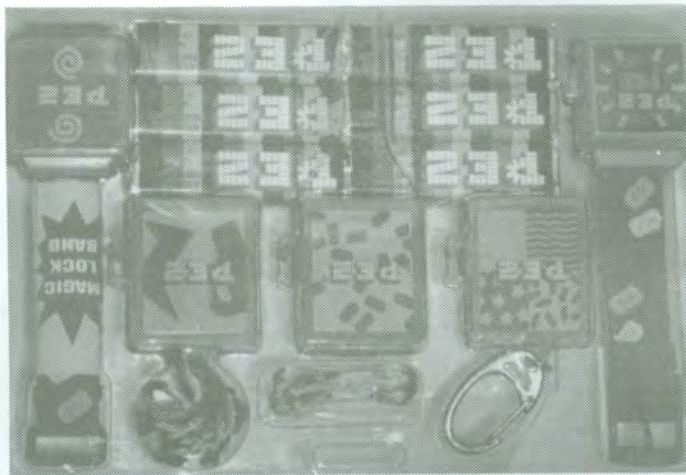

In the Pursuit of PEZ, I have found some new and different items in the stores, particularly Toys-R-Us and FAO Schwarz. Enclosed are photos of the new line of children's "fashion wear" (the PEZant look) - PEZ clip-on, necklace, bracelet, keychain and watch, all of which have a mod-looking design and half capacity PEZ dispenser. All have price tags of about \$3, except for the watch, which is about \$5. The reverse of the card shows a PEZ Teddy bear, but so far that has proven to be elusive.

GO case in a recent FAO Schwarz catalog, pictures six dispensers, rather than the five which are in fact included. All of the above are manufactured by a company called Dream Cas-ite, and so far, all of the dispensers have been manufactured in China.
