**One man's trash is another man's treasure**

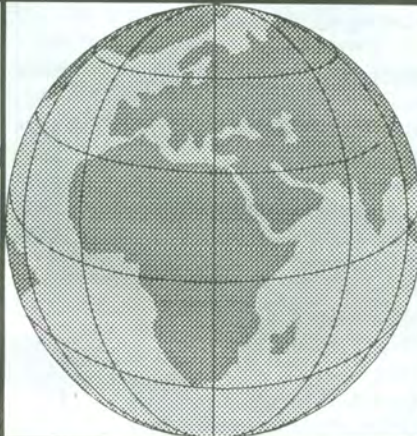
**Y**ou could be tossing out a small fortune when you clean your house.

"No, dust bunnies aren't worth their weight in gold," says author Tony Hyman, "but before taking a shovel to your youngster's room, consider that at least 50 toys from the 1960s and 1970s are worth \$1,000 or more today."

In the last 14 years, Hyman has put more than \$40 million in people's pockets by introducing them to folks ready to pay cash for everything from stuffed armadillos to Zeppelin parts.

Hyman, who is the host of a call-in show in the United States, *Trash or Treasure*, and makes frequent appearances on other radio and television shows.

Hyman's said experience proves you get the best deal when you work with certain buyers.

"People are a lot richer than they think," Hyman said, "but most people don't cash in on what they own because they don't know what they have, who wants it, or how much its worth."

More than 2,000 kinds of things are collected today. The average person can't be an expert in lunch boxes, guns, comic books and kitchenware. Neither can the average antique dealer.

But you don't need to know whether you have a \$5 PEZ dispenser or a \$500 PEZ, he says, as long as you deal with honest experts. Ask them what you have. They will know and pay you fairly.

"You don't go to your butcher with a toothache," Hyman said, "and you don't ask your dentist to fix your flat. Selling collectibles is the same, if you want the best advice and most money, deal with specialists."

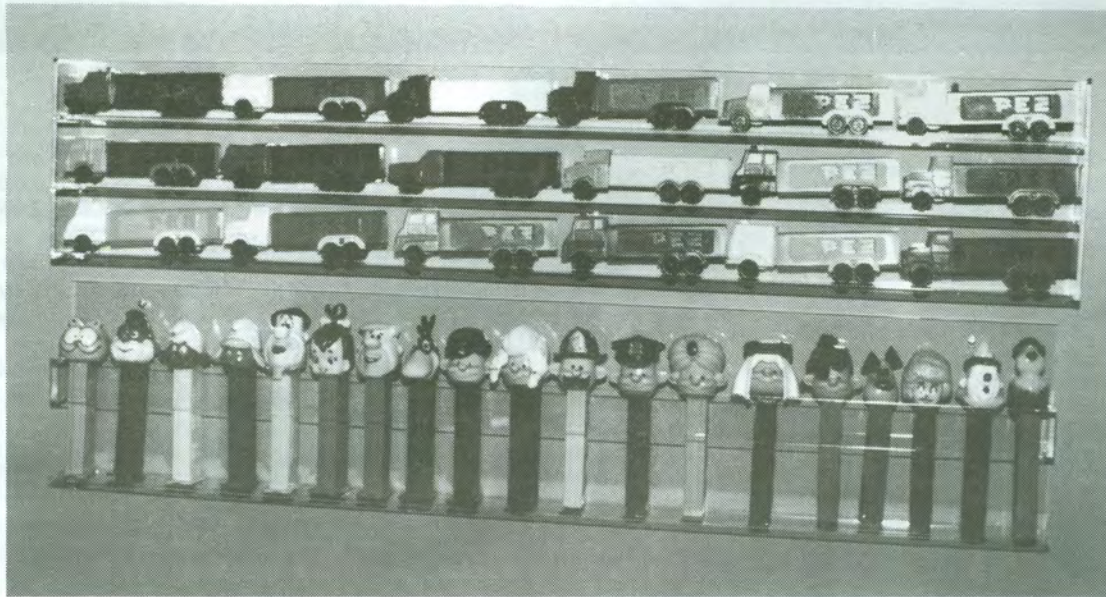
The best buyers may live many miles from you, which is why Hyman advocates selling by mail. It's easy, his fans say, as long as you describe your items carefully, make a photo or photocopy, and include a self-addressed, stamped envelope.

"The old saying about one man's trash being another man's treasure has never been more true," said Hyman.

Something as simple as a plastic PEZ dispenser is worth \$400 to one person and a buck to another, Hyman pointed out, "so I advise people to check out everything and make sure they sell to the right buyer."

# Ask Maria

**W**e hope that you are enjoying a safe and blessed holiday season!

Some good questions have come in, so let's get right to work.

**Question:** My grandchild's like PEZ. They are disappointed that there aren't any Bam-Bam, Betty and Wilma in the Flintstone group. It makes it seem like little boys and mommies are not important. Can you find out if PEZ Company plans to make these?

**Answer:** This question has come in from several collectors who were primarily interested in completing a character line, without having to go to the expensive Zif-fers.

But, you asked it with the most "heart." So I wrote to Mr. McWhinnie at the PEZ Company.

The following is their reply from their Customer Relations Manager:

*"In response to your note to Mr. McWhinnie, we pick characters which are visually the most interesting, also the characters which the licensors suggest are the most popular. That is why "Wilma," "Betty" and "Bam-Bam" are not part of the original Flintstone assortment."*

So... There is the answer. It seems to allow room for future additions... Note the words "original Flintstone assortment."

It is quite an expensive undertaking to produce three more heads. So probably, the company needs to know the feelings of the consumers.

Also, since you sent a SASE, we are sending you a photo of the Flintstone Zif-fers. These are in the collection of John "The Cool PEZ Man" Devlin. They would definitely not be for your grandkid's to play with as they are quite expensive.

**Letter from a teenage collector:**

Dear Maria,

I've started school now and have some very tough classes. I'm in Advanced Placement U.S. History and Cal-

culus. I've got a tough year ahead of me.

I recently received a price list from a collector in Southern California. I can't believe the prices of PEZ now. I figure that it will take two months allowance to get three PEZ if the average PEZ costs \$30.

Tell me how am I going to afford a Green Hornet that costs \$250. I don't have that kind of money.

I get depressed because I see all these adults with their daily jobs and salaries, and how they just trade PEZ that costs \$100+ like it's no big deal.

I can hear all the unfound PEZ in the world shrieking at me at night. It drives me crazy. Everybody else with their die-cuts and their softheads and Eerie Spectres and Full-bodied and PEZ Pals and Premiums and Candy Shooters and Olympics and their color variations and their prototypes and I'm babbling! I CAN'T TAKE IT ANYMORE!!!!

I'm telling you if I had a million dollars, I'd blow it on PEZ in a second. Why can't people just stop buying PEZ from these collectors that charge an arm and a leg and start writing them threatening letters that say I'm going to break your legs if you don't lower prices!

Sorry, I'm a bit stressed about PEZ. If I had known the prices would be like this then I would have bought so many PEZ so long ago. Well I'm thoroughly depressed now. I think I'll go drown my sorrows in root beer.

**Answer:** Your letter reflects the feelings of many collectors. While there is some truth to your complaints, we will try to explain a little about dealer pricing policies.

People who are into dealing on a regular basis, have many expenses.

While it may seem like they make a "lucky" find of a single piece or even a whole older collection, that "luck" is usually the result of a long process.

First, they put ads in toy magazines and they make long distance phone calls to acquire the older PEZ.

Then to offer the PEZ for sale, there is the cost of renting tables at shows, and again advertising in this magazine or other toy magazines.

Dealers spend considerable time on their feet, searching through junk shops, shows, flea markets and so forth.

So when we collectors pay those high prices for a vintage PEZ, we are helping to defray some of those expenses, and for the dealer's swollen ankles.

The only alternative that I can think of, is for each of us to do our own searching.

If you do the foot work yourself, you will understand that the lucky \$25 Green Hornet, really did cost a lot more when you add up the search expenses.

Sometimes, a collector will really make a find, just out of the blue. And it would be good to hear some of those kind of good stories. There have been a few in back issues of this magazine. But, how about some more.

It seems doubtful that prices on the rare items will come down. But sometimes, a dealer will trade an expensive item for several lower priced items. That way, you get a desired PEZ for your collection, and he gets several moderate priced items which are easier to sell. Then, everyone is satisfied! The key here seems to be trust and negotiation.

**Question from Indiana:** I sent a PEZ order to a guy in Canada. About ten days, my letter came back.

It was not opened. I checked the address and it was right.

There was some kind of blurred post office stamp on it. Can you help? I am enclosing the envelope.

**Answer:** You need to put 40-cents worth of postage on any letter to Canada.

Postage to any foreign country is 50-cents... for 1/2 ounce. Use light weight paper and envelope.

Also, do not send SASE to Canadian dealers, because they have to use their own countries' stamps.

It is better to send a dollar when requesting information or lists from them. A self addressed envelope is o.k.

## Tiny candy holders hold value and more

**Q:** My son has collected PEZ candy holders since he was small. He's now 21 and would like to know how to find out more about them, and if they're worth anything.

**A:** Ah, how sweet it'll be for your son's bank account if some of the PEZ candy dispensers he's collected turns out to be among the most rare and valuable examples. Check out his dispensers for value, rarity, importance, and desirability in the newly published book *PEZ Collectibles With Price Guide* by Richard Geary, which contains 281 color photos of PEZ dispensers, along with their full descriptions and current prices. It is available for \$22.90 postpaid from Ace Enterprises, P.O. Box 59354, Chicago, IL 60659.

PEZ dispensers include more than 250 character types (some of which have sold for as much as four figures at auction) along with very rare advertising examples with regular tops, promoting products and places of business (which the book prices as being worth between \$300 and \$400).

PEZ store displays include a circa 1960s Popeye cardboard counter box worth between \$450 and \$750. Also collected are PEZ premiums, such as a circa 1970s

PEZ ghoulish mask with a sticky green face and yellow eyes and nose worth a healthy \$250 to \$300. There are also PEZ clickers, posters, cardboard glasses, package inserts, balloons, tattoos, stickers and everything from a PEZ Alpine hat to a very rare Secret Code Flasher, all of which are pictured and priced in the book.

Memo to mothers: If you have children who left the home and left behind drawers or boxes filled with accumulated stuff, take my advice and look through their possessions in hopes of finding PEZ treasures, which can be converted into cash. To check out or sell PEZ dispensers or related items, write me, enclosing a description or photo of the piece and an addressed stamped envelope, to be put in touch with PEZ sources and clubs.
