PEZ Heads to shoot off their mouths

Who can resist? Go ahead, call them *PEZ Heads*. How can you not?

In an area where fans of Jerry Garcia and his band mates are known as Deadheads, what else can you call the 150 people expected today at the Santa Clara Marriott hotel for the first West Coast convention of fans of the candy known as PEZ.

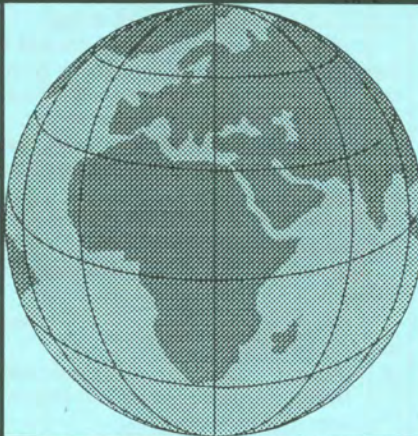
Only, as children of all ages know, this isn't just a candy. It's about those dispensers, the ones with the brightly colored cartoon faces whose mouths open to pass out little bricks of colored sugar and flavoring.

PEZ Heads have sprung up all over the country, attending conventions in St. Louis and Cleveland, putting out a bi-monthly newsletter, "Positively PEZ" for \$18 a year, and taking on a news group on the Prodigy computer network, under collectibles.

The company, based in Orange, Conn., doesn't take part in the conventions and doesn't publish its board of directors or its characters' histories, leaving collectors to debate such things.

Some of the plastic products, which once sold for cents, now sell for thousands of dollars to collectors.

San Jose school psychologist Larry Silveira, 43, is one of the convention's organiz-

ers and a true PEZ Head. He's got 265 of the 324 character dispensers made by the company over the past 42 years, a collection, he figures, that is worth more than \$8,000.

He's got PEZ (the plural is the same as the singular) you haven't seen before, or probably can't afford to see, other than at this convention.

He's got a PEZ about the size of a hand, shaped like the glopoy villain from the movie "Alien," a private designer's fantasy prototype that was never sold by the PEZ company. He also has some fantasy Star Trek characters, again, never created by the PEZ company. The firm shuns real-life characters in favor of cartoons, although there were Betsy Ross and Daniel Boone PEZ dispensers for the Bicentennial.

He's got his favorite, "Psychedelic Eye" PEZ, celebrating San Francisco's "Summer of Love" with its "LUV PEZ" sticker on the side — a hippie vision now worth \$300.

Of course he's got Popeye in several ver-

sions, Mickey Mouse, the Smurfs, Garfield, Frankenstein, the PEZ Pals: PEZzie Boy and PEZzie Girl, Santa Claus, Spiderman, the Flintstones and several original PEZ-style dispensers that look like throwaway cigarette lighters.

He doesn't have the all-time rarest PEZ, "Make-a-Face" PEZ, which looks like Mr. Potato Head and came out in the 1970s. If you have one stashed in the attic, don't let someone sucker you into thinking it's junk. A PEZ Head will give you \$2,400 of more for it.

So how does a grown man — one who seems quite sane on the surface, is a licensed marriage and family counselor and also counsels Gilroy high school kids — get into collecting PEZ?

"I started buying them in 1970," said Silveira, who was raised in Castro Valley. "I always liked them. They just amazed me. I just thought they were works of art. They are all hand-crafted and when you think about it, it's pop art."

Silveira says his love of PEZ connects him to his childhood.

"It's something from my past that still lets me be a kid," he said. "But I'll admit, you have to be a certain kind of obsessive/compulsive personality to collect like this."

He started collecting them casually, buying the dispensers in stores at cost — to the astonishment of everyone, including a psychologist who was analyzing him — but only learned four years ago they were worth money. Then began spending more for rare PEZ.

"Now I can tell him why I did it — it's for the money."

Silveira's living room is a shrine to PEZ. He's got a painted redwood altar with rows and rows of PEZ dispensers smiling out at visitors. He's got PEZ puzzles, PEZ posters and a full-sized cardboard PEZ store sales display case.

His 9-year-old daughter, Jade, who collects marbles, thinks it's all a bit strange.

"I think it's sort of weird and it's sort of cool," she said. It's weird because a grown man is spending all this money to buy these. But it's cool because they are sort of neat."

Not neat enough, however, to dazzle her. "Some day all of this will be yours," Silveira told her.

"No way dad," she said. "I'm gonna sell it and buy a hot, fast car."

She wants a Lexus or convertible, she added.

If you go to the convention, you will learn all kinds of PEZ facts:

- ◆ Celebrity PEZ collectors include Demi Moore, Charlie Sheen and Billy Mummy, from "Lost in Space."
- ◆ The candy was originally made in 1927 by an Austrian, Eduard Haas. It's name comes from a shortening of the German word for peppermint, *Pfefferminz*.
- ◆ It came to the U.S. in 1952, where it flopped when it was marketed to adults as a breath mint in its plain dispensers. When Haas added cartoon characters for kids, it took off.
- ◆ There was a Bullwinkle, but not a Rocky PEZ, a Fred Flintstone and Barney Rubble, but not a Wilma or Bam Bam. Some outsider made an Adolph Hitler PEZ, but was ordered to stop by the company.
- ◆ European manufactured PEZ candy tastes fruitier and less chemical than its American counterpart. The nearest place you can buy it, however, is Canada.

A lot of PEZ Pals are gearing up for the summer conventions. We have been to four of them. We encourage you to give it a try. It is a lot of fun!

We will try to answer PEZ and hobby questions on this page. If you need a quick answer, please send a SASE.

Your positive input is always welcome, too.

Question from NJ:

We have heard a lot of pro and con about keeping our PEZ in the package or taking them out. We don't care what's "wrong or right," we just want to know if Maria keeps PEZ in or out?

Answer:

All of my PEZ are out. The reporter from the newspaper and the television did not want them in packages.

Actually, they did me a big favor, as we enjoy them so much more, now that all the PEZ are out. We can arrange them and enjoy them.

For instance, some sunny day, line up a row of little chick PEZ on the windowsill. They look so cute in their little red hats. When the sun comes in, you can almost hear them peeping.

The chicks are the only full body production PEZ on a stick type dispenser ever made.

Sometimes, I line up a whole row of Fred PEZ... and imagine them saying "Yabba-Dabba-Do"... "Honey, I'm Home."

Sometimes, I make a snow scene with fluffy snow, pine trees and lots of PEZ Snowman.

The one on the black base is called Parson Brown. And all the

white Snowman are named after my PEZ friends.

To me, the point of any hobby type of collection is to have fun. And Maria can have more fun with the PEZ out of the packages.

All others can decide for themselves, on the in or out question.

Question:

I would like to have some PEZ blister cards for mounting. But I can not get the plastic bubble off them without wrecking the card. Do you have any suggestions?

Answer:

When we first started in the hobby, we tried various methods, but were never able to free the plastic from the backing.

I guess it is suppose to stick tight so the product doesn't fall out! If anyone else can suggest a solution, please write. It would be fun to have some of them in your collection.

Question:

I want to know about the Peter PEZ dispenser. When was it issued first? How can I get a artwork page about it? At the meet last year, I got artwork for some of the other PEZ.

Answer:

One way that we will know what year the first Peter PEZ was issued is to ask long time collectors to write in and tell us when they first made the purchase new?

By artwork, I am assuming you mean a glossy ad sheet? After checking with a distributor, I have found out that there seems to be None - directly on the Peter PEZ dispenser.

However, as we all know, Peter PEZ is the company logo. His picture appears on their letterhead and color brochures.

My best Michigan PEZ Pal has a store display from the olden days of U.S. PEZ...it is a big Peter PEZ face.

So apparently, he was more in the company promotional policies back then.

The big Peter PEZ faces do not seem to be used now in the U.S. displays. But they are still widely used in Europe and Canada.

I like the PEZ clown. The dispenser is fun and colorful. It came as a huge surprise when the new Peter PEZ came on the market in 1993.

I was searching the check-out PEZ racks for Flintstones and there was a Peter PEZ!

I immediately called a local distributor to see about acquiring a whole case for the collectors. But the distributor didn't know anything about the Peter PEZ. I bought a few extra and sent one to him.

Peter seems to be well circulated around the country now. You should all be able to have him in your collection.

On some of the older displays, Peter PEZ is holding the Pilot PEZ.

The Peter PEZ and Easter Bunny header cards from Europe is really delightful. And the old Peter PEZ vinyl placemat is a real nice collectors item, too.

Question:

In the January issue, you said that the Dinosaurs are coming to the U.S. stores. I still can't find any...when are they due out?

Answer:

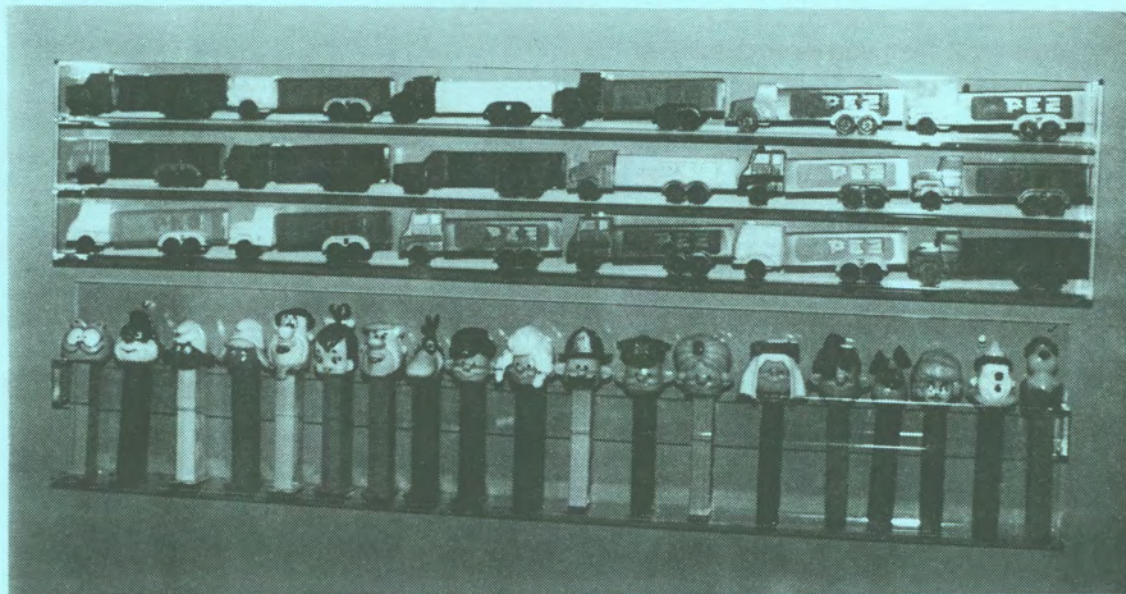
Most any day now. They were due to start circulating around the first of April. However, it does take a while to get them into the stores.

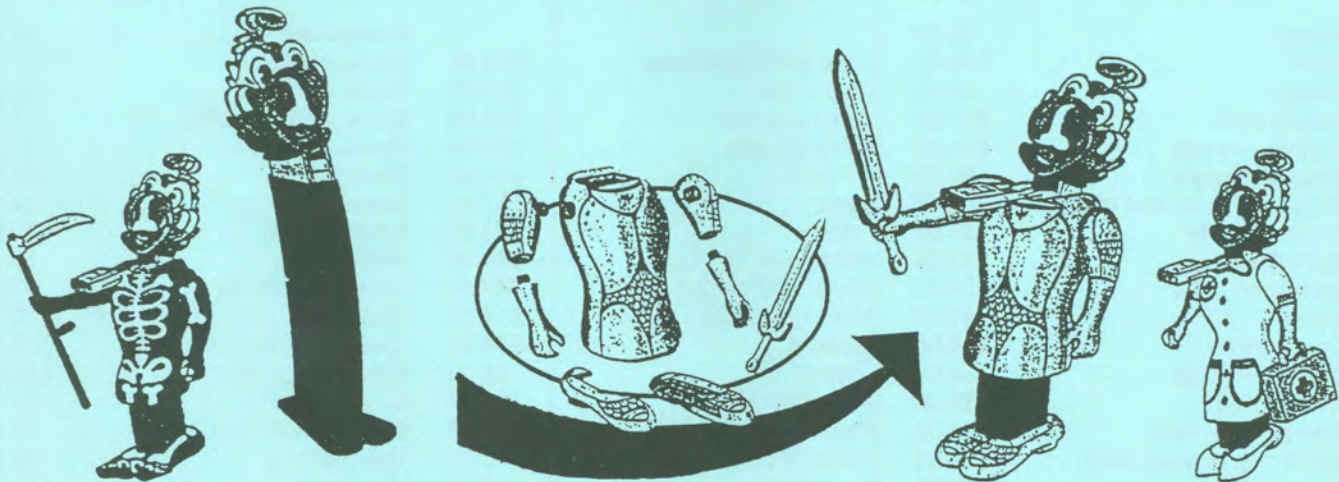
