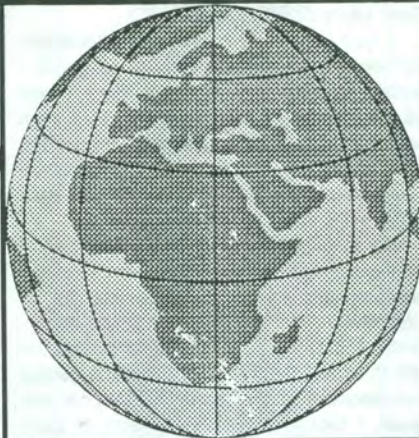
Answer:

While, it is true that some people are moving on, and selling off... so many more people are coming into the hobby.

Question:

How come when I answer a classified ad by phone... the guy never calls me back? I am a new collector and trying to learn.

Answer:

Most PEZ advertised in classified are "only one" available. So, if the PEZ is already sold, your call is not returned. If a person has to return 10 long distance calls, his expense is more than his sale.

On the other side of the coin, some people call on ads that are several months old. Back when I was really working on building our collection, and advertising every issue, checks and orders would come like

six months after my ads. What could I do? Just send them back. In most cases, old ads are no good.

If you leave your address... then the seller should at least send you a postcard, so you will know the PEZ is sold.

Shortly after I sent in my page for the last issue, I was talking to a couple PEZ Pals about that problem of getting the plastic blister off the cardboard.

One person suggested using the vaporizer. He said just steam it loose. Then dab very carefully with a paper towel and all the glue would come off. Next, lay cards flat, cover with plastic food wrap and a towel then put a heavy book on top. When dry, the card should be as good as new.

Another person said that a steam kettle works okay, too. You just need to be very careful because steam can burn.

The candy might go soft during the process, but should be okay when dried. And of course, just dry off the PEZ dispenser. So, thanks for these suggestions.

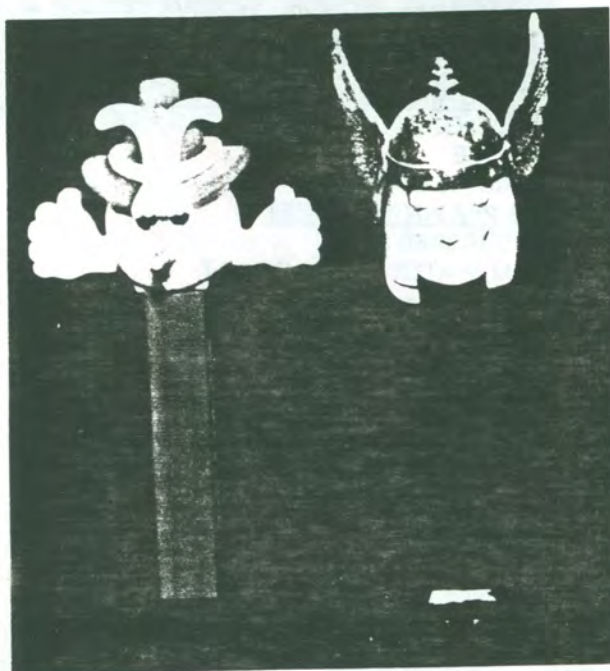

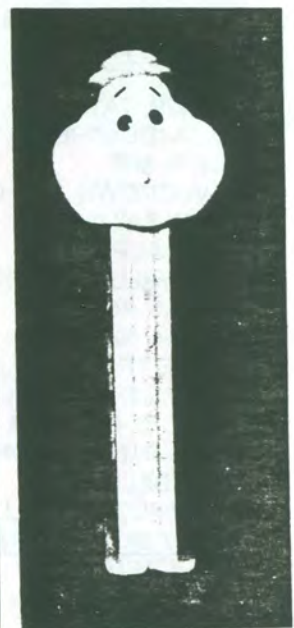

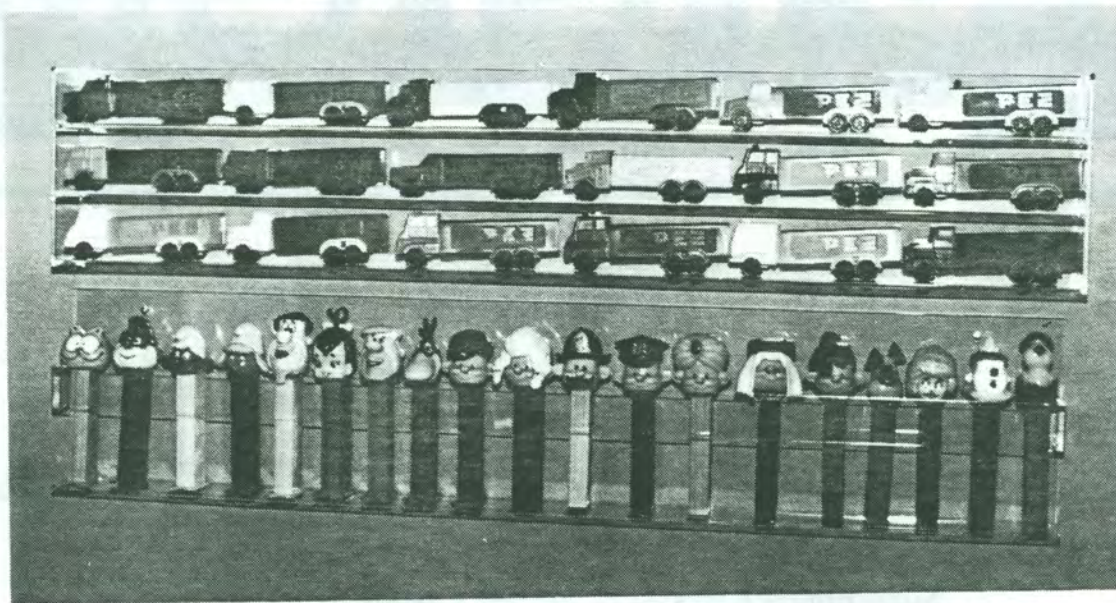
