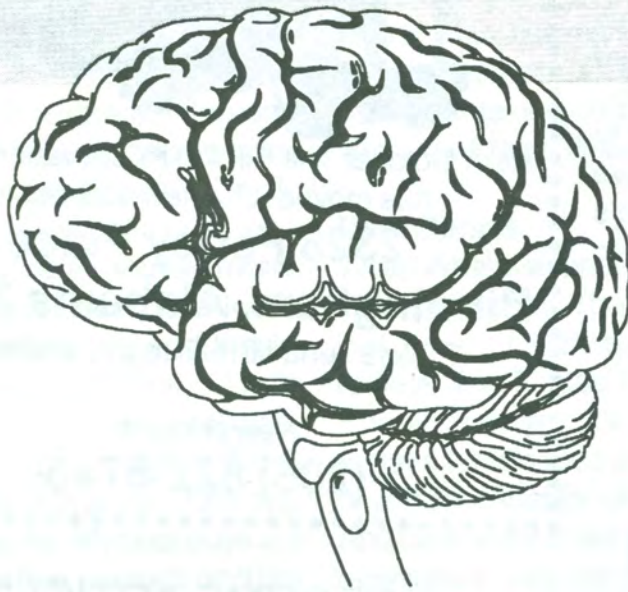

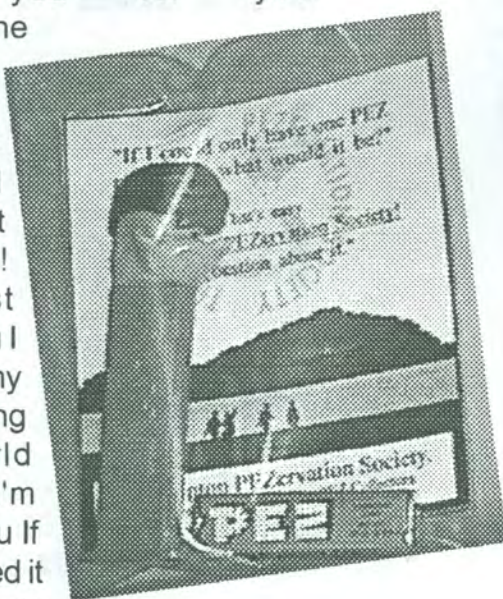


# THE FLIPTOP PEZERVATION SOCIETY Newsletter

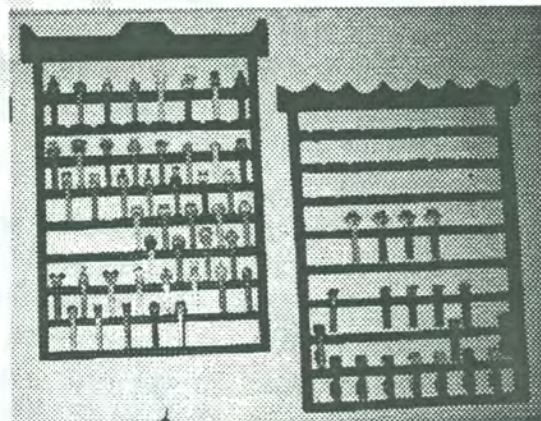

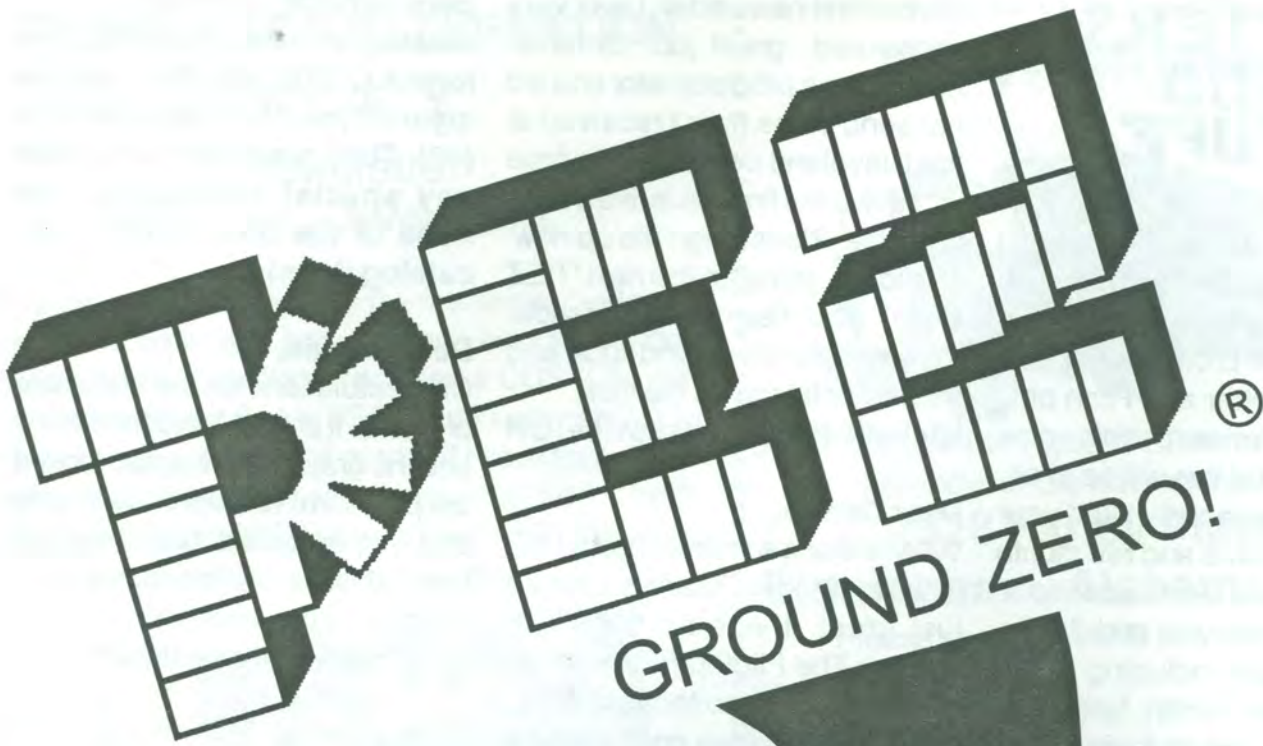

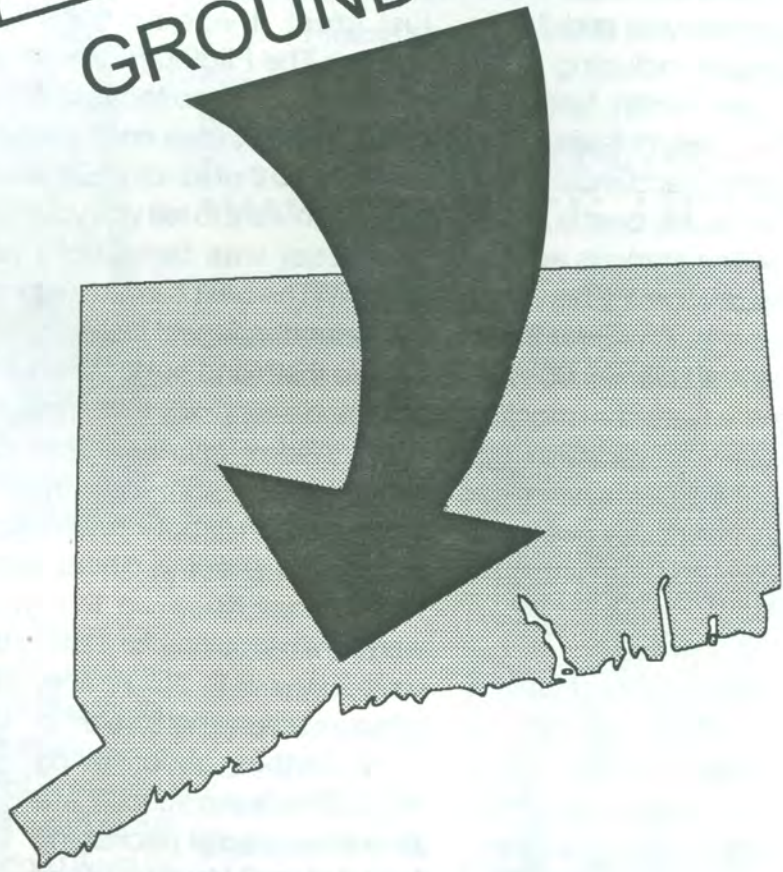
Nestled deep in Connecticut just west of interstate 95 sits the small town of Orange. And like most towns...it has a claim to fame...something to put it on the map. How appropriate that the town is named Orange. For that's just one of the flavors of world famous candy that is created there.

The year was 1972. The events of that year will be long remembered. Richard Nixon was President, the Vietnam war was going strong, Governor Wallace was shot, Israeli Olympic athletes were slain in Munich. In the midst of all this world chaos, PEZ Candy Inc. moves into Orange, Connecticut. They open a new factory and churn out thousands of now classic dispensers that you could buy for under fifty cents. Boy, those were the days.

Today, it's from this small factory of approximately 150 employees that we all look to for that next great addition to our collections. PEZ Candy Inc. doesn't actually make the dispensers here. They're made overseas in countries like Austria, Hungary, Czech Republic,



Slovenia and China.(also Hong Kong and USA in the past) Then they're shipped state side and packaged with the candy made in Orange. The factory currently makes orange, lemon, grape, strawberry and assorted flavors...as well as sugar free orange lemon and strawberry. There's even a Kosher PEZ! The company discontinued cherry a few years ago but it's still made in other countries. The factory sells tens of millions of dispensers each year. (They sell more dispensers each year than there are kids in





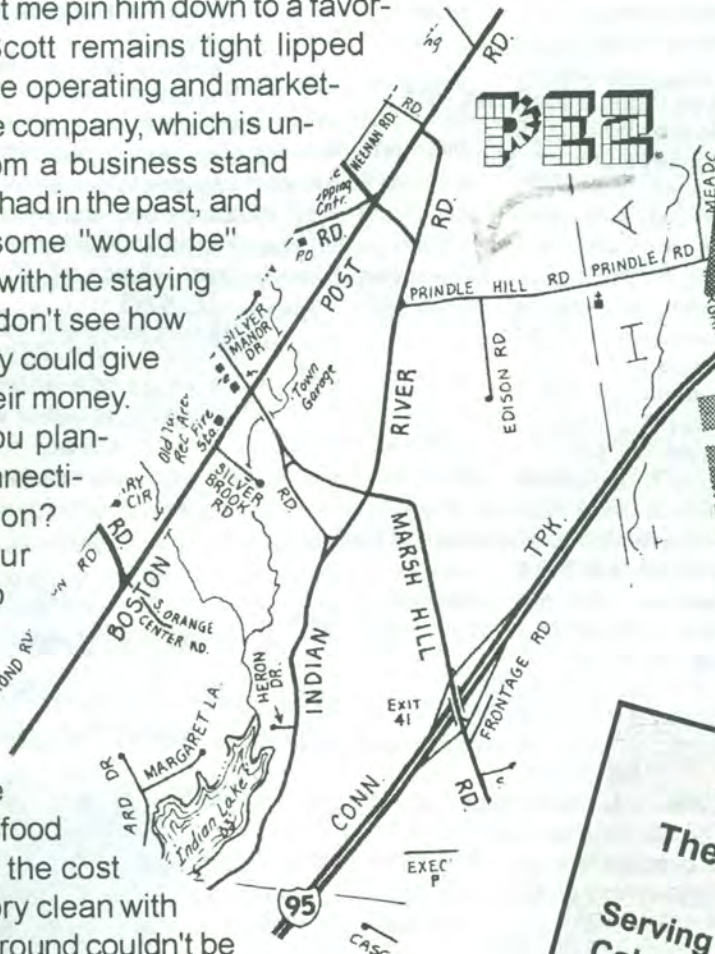
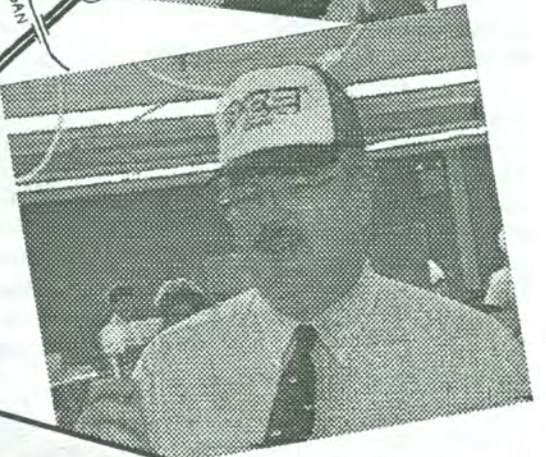
the US!) Currently PEZ Candy USA has approximately 60 dispensers on the market, not including color variations.

PEZ Candy Inc. is a privately owned company...so you can't buy stock. Also, PEZ USA is not affiliated with PEZ in other countries. They communicate with each other and sometimes share the cost of making a new dispenser, but they are separately owned and separately managed. PEZ USA has been under the helm of "Pezzident" Scott McWinnie since 1983. I asked Scott about the favorite part of his job. He says the process of deciding what new dispenser to make and what the packaging will look like can be quite fun at times.

(Scott wouldn't let me pin him down to a favorite dispenser) Scott remains tight lipped about many of the operating and marketing aspects of the company, which is understandable from a business standpoint. They have had in the past, and currently have some "would be" competition. But with the staying power of PEZ, I don't see how any new company could give them a run for their money.

So are you planning a trip to Connecticut anytime soon? Well, save your gas. Contrary to popular belief, PEZ doesn't offer tours. Part of the reason is they're a FDA regulated food plant. (I assume the cost to keep the factory clean with tours stomping around couldn't be justified) Plus they don't have the staff to run tours or a gift shop. But don't think they're too busy for us. They're just busy planning that next great head to squeeze onto your PEZ shelf. So keep your eyes on Orange and clear a space on your shelf. That's what it's all about anyway isn't it?

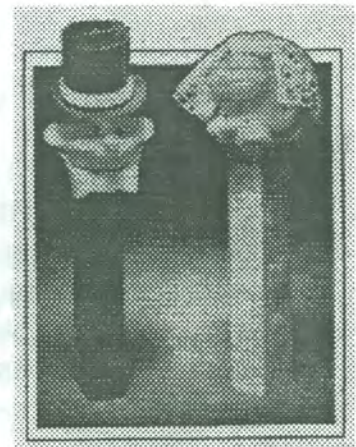

# FRAME OF REFERENCE!

## Your Guides To The Hobby

There are many articles written about PEZ, but if you want to study up on different dispensers and see varying checklists...here's a list of reference material from past and present.

**"The Optimistic Pezzamist"**-The first Newsletter for PEZ collectors featured many articles and checklists. Published by Mike Robertson of Dripping Springs Texas. Ceased publication. Still available as Xerox copies from long time collectors.

**"The Pocket Guide to PEZ"**-Mike Robertson's checklist of PEZ in a small 3 x 4 inch book. Featured one dispenser per page (no photos) and had boxes to check off when you acquired a dispenser. Descriptions of dispensers featured things like number of parts contained on a particular head. Originally sold for \$6.00...no longer available.

**"Toy Values Monthly"**- (#4"-1991) Toy magazine (now known as Collectible Toys & Values). Featured a 6 page interview with PEZ president Scott McWinnie and fairly complete checklist. (Although the prices listed were all wrong, even for 1991) Features photos from some of the PEZ in Scott's office. At last check this magazine was still available through back order.

**"Tomart's Garage Sale Gold"**-General price guide for many kinds of collectibles. Features about a page of PEZ prices. Still available at the bookstore.

**"Toy Collector & Price Guide"** magazine- (June 1993) Features a 3 page article by Sue Sternfeld and comprehensive checklist. Includes a few photos of the rarer PEZ.

**"Positively PEZ"**-Back issues of Larry Lafoe's PEZ newsletter features checklists of all known PEZ. Still available as Xerox from collectors

**"A Pictorial Guide to Plastic Candy Dispensers"**  
-David Welch's first book about PEZ. This book was the first to feature photos as the main attraction. Still available from David Welch (618-687-2282) for about \$23.00

**"Collectors Price Guide to PEZ"**-Published by Mike Edelman (708-431-6955) & John LaSpina. Text only price guide that is easily pocketed for that quick trip

to the flea market. This publication has been continually updated over the last 4 or 5 years and is still available for about \$10.00

**"PEZ Collectibles"**-Richard Geary's long awaited picture book shows many of the best photos ever taken of PEZ dispensers. Over a hundred pages of full color pictures and price ranges for almost every PEZ ever made. This book sells for \$19.95 and is available in your local bookstore, or can be ordered directly from Richard Geary (PO Box 622 Madison, OH 44057)

**"Guide to Plastic Collectibles"**-Another book about a number of different plastic collectibles. Features about a page of PEZ prices. Available at your local bookstore.

**"Collecting PEZ"**-This is one of the largest books ever written about PEZ and is the second from David Welch. It is about 350 pages and delves into the history and people behind PEZ. Available directly from David Welch (618-687-2282) for about \$45.00

**"1995 Toys & Prices"**-price guide to many toys with an almost complete list of dispensers. Available at bookstore for about \$20.00

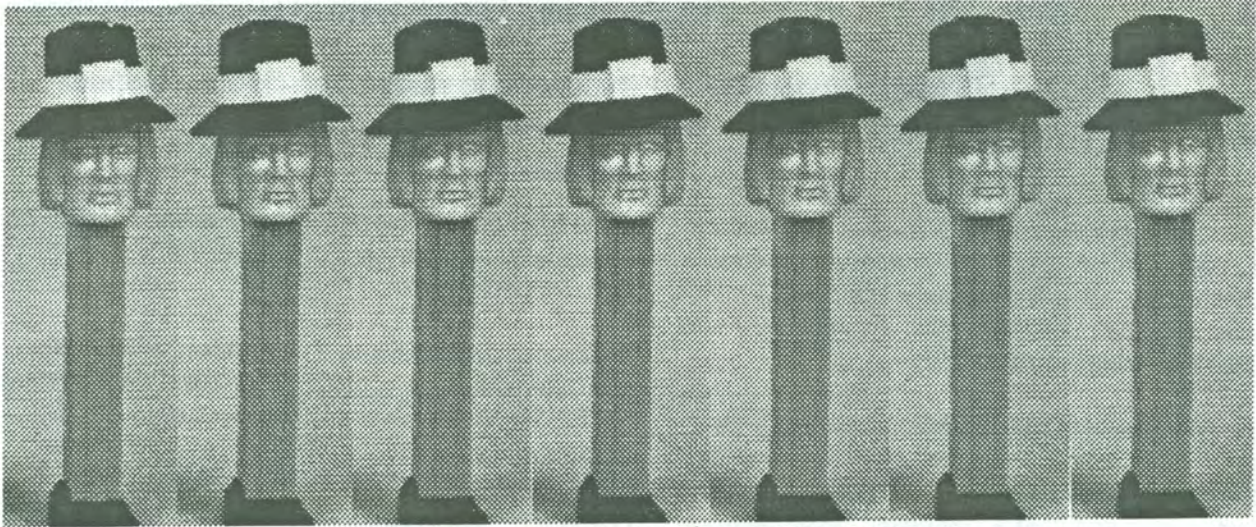
**"The Fliptop PEZervation Society"**-Sure to be a legendary reference tool for PEZ collectors.

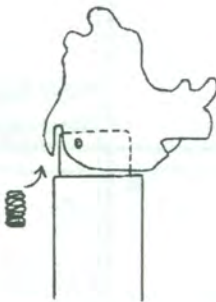
We've all heard stories about how a kid learned to build a bomb from the internet. Well, here's some instructions to build your own PEZ gun that I got off the internet. (I added drawings to make them a little more understandable) Be careful!

## How to build a PEZ Gun by Matt Shook

So, you can't afford one of those official PEZ guns available in the 50's and 80's? Well, here's how you can make your own PEZ that shoots candy.

The materials you need to make a PEZ gun are:

- A PEZ dispenser
- A spring from a ball-point pen
- Double sided tape
- A pair of needle-nosed pliers (or wire cutters)
- A package of PEZ candy (ammo)



Spring slides onto tab on dispenser head.



Spring momentarily "catches" on stem



Spring pops loose and sends candy flying!

Take the double sided tape and wrap it around the little plastic tab that pushes the candy out of the dispenser. Then use the pliers (or cutters) to shorten the spring. Then stick the spring around the double sided tape. The spring should be long enough to be shoved all the way up the PEZ tab and go straight down to touch the cartridge. If it's too long or too short the gun won't work. Don't worry if your gun doesn't work the first time. After my initial burst of PEZZY inspiration, it took me three hours and four pen springs to finally get one that would shoot at all. But the more you make, the more you get a feel for the spring size and tension and the easier it will get to make them and you can get them to shoot farther.

My first PEZ gun only shot about two feet and was only good for shooting them into your mouth. The latest one I've made can shoot about twelve feet and can cause pain to humans at point blank range. The object is to get the spring just long enough so it catches on the cartridge and then pops forward just as the head reaches it's full tilt...thus sending the candy flying. Once you have made a PEZ gun you too will feel the satisfaction one gets from pulling out a dispenser and popping some of the sweet candy into your mouth with only a flick of a finger. (I tried this and made it work on the first try. COOL!....dm)

Given PEZ Boy's bizarre thatch of brown hair, I assumed he was supposed to be an 11 year old Ted Koppel. In fact, I had been referring to him as "Baby Ted PEZ." Man, is my face red!

But I never would have discovered the truth if I hadn't visited Gary's PEZ museum at 214 California Drive. OK, so it's just a humble display at the back of his CD-ROM software rental store, Computer Spectrum. As far as PEZ devotees are concerned, it's a shrine. "Yeah, Burlingame High School is down the street, and those kids are always over here," Gary said. "Some people are fascinated by PEZ." (Tell me about it!) ...Seeing Gary's PEZ display reminded me of some great PEZ unsolved mysteries. Why was there a Bullwinkle PEZ but no Rocky? "You think that's weird; in Hungary they made plastic clip-on costumes for the dispensers," he said, shining

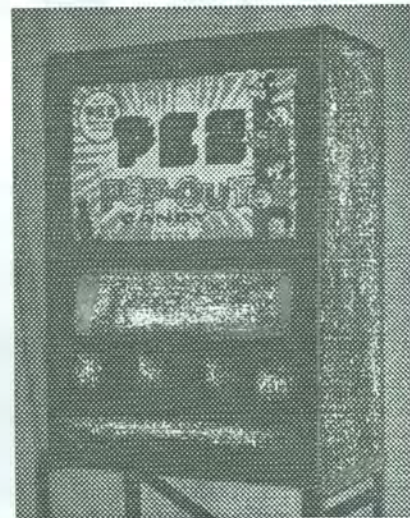
